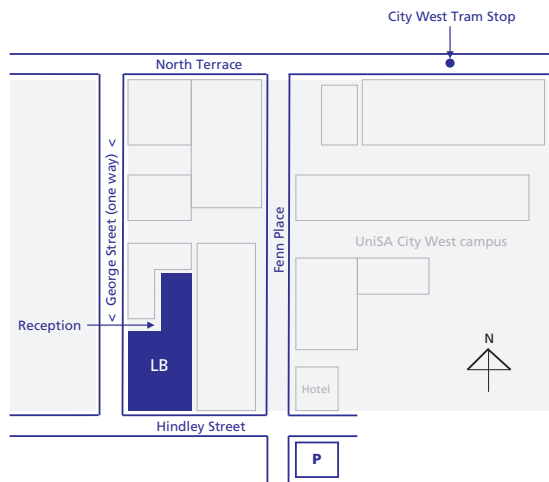

Appointments

Appointments will be conducted at the Legal Advice Clinic, located in the Law Building at UniSA's City West campus (see map on reverse).

When you arrive at the Law Building, please report to reception for your appointment.

Initial appointments are conducted as 40 minute interviews. You will be given an opportunity to discuss your legal problem with a law student. The law student will then confer with the supervising solicitor. On some occasions you will be able to obtain advice on the same day. In some circumstances, the students may need to do some research and provide advice in a follow-up appointment at a later date or in a letter.

Please bring all the documents you have regarding your legal issue to your appointment.

The UniSA Legal Advice Clinic provides confidential, free legal advice to members of the community.
