Magill campus is only seven kilometres from central Adelaide and is reachable from the city by bus. Many students drive to Magill and limited car parking is available on-campus.

From the North

O-Bahn

Take the bus from Paradise and Tea Tree Plaza Interchange by O-Bahn to/from Adelaide. The O-Bahn is a Mega Go Zone with a maximum wait of 15 minutes, 7 days a week until 10pm.

Travel time: 14-20 mins

Train

Train times to and from Adelaide range from every 15 minutes during peak times to every 30 minutes at other times.

Travel time: 25-35 mins

Bus

The 107X Uni-Express bus service between Adelaide and Magill campus takes 20 minutes and runs every 15 minutes. The T501 or O-Bahn buses go to Paradise then take bus 125, 580 to Magill campus.

Travel time: 20 mins

From the East

Bus

Bus 106 runs along the Magill Road Go Zone to the Magill campus. From Adelaide Bus 125 travels to Magill and takes 15 minutes or the Uni-Express bus 107X takes 20 minutes and runs every 15-30 minutes.

Travel time: 15-20 mins



From the West

Bus

Catch a bus along these Go Zones to Adelaide - Torrens Road, Hawker Street, Port, Grange, Tapleys Hill, Henley Beach, Crittendon and Richmond Roads and Sir Donald Bradman Drive. Buses every 15 minutes, 7.30am-6.30pm weekdays. Buses 155, 156 and 157 run to/from West Lakes Shopping Centre along Port Road to the City every 15 minutes and take about 30 mins. Connect with bus 107X from North Terrace to Magill campus every 15 minutes.

Travel time: 50 mins

From the South

Train

Take the train from Noarlunga Centre Interchange to Adelaide, it will take 30-45 minutes, then take the Uni-Express bus 107X to the Magill campus, buses run every 15-30 minutes.

Travel time: 50 mins

Bus

Catch a bus along these Go Zones to Adelaide - Main South Road, South Road, Anzac Highway and Marion Road. Buses every 15 minutes, 7.30am-6.30pm weekdays.

Travel time: 40 mins

Parking

There is limited parking available on campus, fees apply daily and annually.

Mawson Lakes campus can be reached from the city by bus and a train service runs to the nearby Mawson Interchange. The campus is 20 minutes north of the Adelaide city centre.

From the North

O-Bahn

Take any O-Bahn bus from Tea Tree Plaza Interchange and transfer to bus 565 or from Paradise Interchange take bus T501 to Mawson Lakes campus.

Travel time: 45-50 mins

Train

Take the train from Hi Frequency stations - Gawler, Tambelin, Smithfield, Elizabeth and Salisbury to Mawson Interchange every 15 minutes, 7.30am-6.30pm weekdays

Travel time: 15-35 mins

Bus

Catch bus 225 from Salisbury Interchange, or along these Go Zones - Main North, North East, Prospect and Churchill Roads or JetBuses via the O-Bahn Mega Go Zone.

Travel time: 15-25 mins

Parking

There is limited parking available on campus,



From the East

Train

Travel by train from Adelaide to Mawson Lakes, times range from 15-30 minutes.

Travel time: 30 mins

Bus

Take the bus to Adelaide along these Go Zones - Duthy Street, Goodwood, Unley and King William Roads, Winston Avenue, Glen Osmond, Payneham and Magill Roads, Coorara Avenue, The Parade and Kensington Road. Then take the train to Mawson Lakes.

Travel time: 35 mins.

From the West

Train

Take the train from Grange, Woodville, Port Adelaide or Glanville to Adelaide, it will take about 20 minutes, then connect with the train to Mawson Lakes.

Travel by train from Adelaide to Mawson Lakes, times range from every 15 minutes during peak times to every 30 minutes at other times.

Travel time: 30-40 mins

Bus

Catch a bus along these Go Zones to Adelaide - Torrens, Port, Grange, Tapleys Hill, Henley Beach, Crittendon and Richmond Roads and Sir Donald Bradman Drive. Buses every 15 minutes, 7.30am-6.30pm weekdays. Buses 155, 156 and 157 run to/from West Lakes Shopping Centre along Port Road to the City then connect with the train to Mawson Lakes.

Travel time: 35 mins



Mawson Lakes campus

From the South

Train

Take the train from Brighton, Hallett Cove, Tonsley or Noarlunga Centre Interchange to Adelaide, it will take 30-50 minutes, then take the train to Mawson Lakes. Travel time to Mawson Lakes is 13-20 mins and trains run every 15-30 minutes.

Travel time: 50 mins

Bus

Bus T721 runs from Noarlunga Centre Interchange to Adelaide every 30 minutes along Main South Road, South Road and Anzac Highway. Travel by train from Adelaide to Mawson Lakes every 15-30 minutes.

Travel time: 57 mins

Tram

Travel to Adelaide by tram from Glenelg is approx. 29 minutes. Trams run every 7½ minutes at peak times and every 10-20 minutes at other times from early morning to midnight 7 days a week. Travel by train from Adelaide to Mawson Lakes every 15-30 minutes.

Travel time: 30-40 mins

From the North

O-Bahn

Take the O-Bahn from Tea Tree Plaza or Paradise Interchange to Adelaide. The O-Bahn is a Mega Go Zone with a maximum wait of 15 minutes, 7 days a week until 10pm.

Travel time: 14-20 mins

Train

Take the train from Hi Frequency stations - Gawler, Tambelin, Smithfield, Elizabeth and Salisbury to Mawson Interchange every 15 minutes, 7.30am-6.30pm weekdays

Travel time: 15-35 mins

Bus

Catch a bus along these Go Zones to Adelaide - North East, Main North, Prospect and Churchill Roads or *JetBuses* via the O-Bahn Mega Go Zone.

From the East

Bus

Parking

From the South

Train

Take the train from Brighton, Hallett Cove, Tonsley or Noarlunga Centre Interchange to Adelaide.

Travel time: 30-50 mins

Bus

Bus T721 runs from Noarlunga Centre Interchange to Adelaide every 30 minutes along Main South and South Roads and Anzac Highway.

Travel time: 57 mins

Catch a Go Zone Bus to Adelaide from Main South and South Roads, Anzac Highway and Marion Road. Buses every 15 minutes, 7.30am-6.30pm weekdays.

Travel time: 40 mins

Tram

The tram to UniSA's City West campus from Glenelg runs every 7½ minutes at peak times and every 10-20 minutes at other times from early morning to midnight 7 days a week. Free travel from South Terrace to the City West campus.

Travel time: 29 mins

Adelaide Free

The Adelaide Free City Loop (99c) bus provides free transport approximately every 15 minutes. Monday to Friday between City East Campus (Stop 10 or 28), Railway Station (Stop 8 or 25), City West Campus (Stop 6, 7, 22 or 23) and Victoria Square.

Train

Catch a bus along these Go Zones to Adelaide - Main South Road, South Roads, Anzac Highway and Marion Road.

Travel time: 40 mins

Tram

The tram to King William Street from Glenelg runs every 7½ minutes at peak times and every 10-20 minutes at other times from early morning to midnight 7 days a week. Free travel from South Terrace to the City West campus.

Travel time: 29 mins

Parking

Car parking can be scarce in the city centre so public transport is recommended.

Adelaide Free

The Adelaide Free City Loop (99c) bus provides free transport approximately every 15 minutes. Monday to Friday between City East Campus (Stop 10 or 28), Railway Station (Stop 8 or 25), City West Campus (Stop 6, 7, 22 or 23) and Victoria Square.



Bikes

Bikes travel free on trains after 9am and before 3pm and after 6pm Monday to Friday and all day on weekends and public holidays. A concession ticket is required for bicycles travelling on board a train outside of these times. There are Bike Lockers at most locations throughout the public transport system and for a deposit you can hire a bike locker to securely store your bike. Call Adelaide Metro Infoline on 8210 1000 for details

Adelaide Station and Noarlunga Centre Interchange have bike storage rooms where you are able to store your bike for free, but you must provide your own lock and chain.

There is free parking for bikes and scooters on and around all UniSA campuses.
