Thoughts

Predominantly Verdelho and Viognier, **the Timbuktu Small Block White** is a fruity number, with good texture and some nice fruit...screwcap

Meerea Park has hit the ground running in recent times, picking up a swag of accolades and awards for their wines. This Sem is produced from 40 year old vines owned by the Howard family- who are pretty much Hunter viticultural royalty. This edition is long and intense, offering citrus and fresh cut hay, green apple zing and a hint of spice. Have it now with seafood, or cellar and wait for the lanolin and toast to emerge...screwcap

Halliday considers **Poverty Hill Wines** to be one of the 10 best new wineries saying '...the quality of the wines is – quite simply – inspiring' This month we are offering you the Poverty Hill Riesling and Poverty Hill Cabernet which Halliday rated 95/100. **Poverty Hill's Riesling** is all about citrus, with lime and lemon competing on a palate which is taut and long... If the superb 01 offers any indication, the 07 should cellar magnificently. Vines are over 100 years old. ... screwcap The **Cabernet** is extremely intense, showing blackcurrant, mint and dark fruit all set within a richly textured body and finished by fine but persistent tannins- a ripper ... screwcap

Hamilton's Rose is a good quaffer. Sourced from Grenache vines, this is a bright, fruity wine with good fruit, good acidity and a decent amount of sugar to finish...screwcap Their **Slate Quarry Riesling** is consistently McLaren Vale's best Riesling, often challenging the best of Clare, Eden, and Frankland for quality. This edition is of medium intensity, with good lime notes, good pallet length and a dry finish- lovely now with antipasto, but can be cellared...screwcap

Old Mill Estate Rose is an intriguing wine, made entirely from Touriga. Raspberries and Maraschino cherry flavours abound and this one has enough structure to cope with barbecued meats, but enough delicacy to drink as a summery treat ...screwcap... Interestingly, Cheong Liew (OAM for services to food and restaurant industry) of Grange restaurant fame thought highly enough of it to include it on one of his degustation menus

Wangolina Station Washpool Sauvignon Blanc is a good quaffing SB. It is light and fresh, offering nice green characters and good length...screwcap

Gemtree's Citrine Chardonnay has just picked up a Gold at the Sydney wine show. The wine is zesty, with lime and extra citrus, and a spot of pear too. The pallet is similar with some nice toastiness derived from being fermented in 30% new French oak ... screwcap

McGuigan Sparkling is an excellent quaffer. It's not Dom, but for a tenner its good value- creamy with good texture and a splash of toast thrown in ... cork

Tyrrell's Lost Block Sem has just picked up a 93/100 from Halliday. For mine it's the best one produced to date, with plenty of zippy citrus zest on the nose and pallet. Flavours are intense and citrusy, with excellent length. Perfect with seafood or on its own...screwcap

Bird in Hand Sparkling is fast achieving cult status, and with good reason. The wine is soft, creamy and strawberry laden, with excellent length and beautiful balance...sooo easy to drink, crack it with a fruit and cheese platter...cork

Gemtree's Tatty Road is a blend of Cabernet, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc and Merlot (40/30/20/10% respectively) and it's a fantastic wine, reminiscent of a ripe Bordeaux. It's clean with ripe, dark fruit and a benevolent herbal edge that makes your mouth water ... screwcap

Zema Estate's Shiraz is from a pretty flash vintage for the Coonawarra (Halliday rates it 9/10).

Hamilton's Gumpr's Block Shiraz has been on the up and up over the last 3 vintages, and this, the 06 edition continues the stride... screwcap

Mountadam Barossa Shiraz offers ripe thick fruit, spice and a hint of liquorice ... screw cap

Pirathon (pinnacle) is Kalleske's take on Shiraz from the best, non estate fruit from the Barossa, sourced from north-western vineyards. Greenock, Stonewell, Moppa, Koonunga, Seppeltsfield and Ebenezer vineyards all supply fruit for this wine, which is a big, oaky, fruitful number which can be drunk now or cellared for eons ... cork

Timbuktu has provided us with 2 reds for this months specials, the **Big Block Red** and the **Deluxe Red**.

Mereea Park has picked up some serious press in the last year or 3, all of it deserved... Fair to say their reds are decidedly un Hunter like- more polished fruit and intensity than is considered the norm by some... their Shiraz Viognier is a beautiful red, quite complex and plush, soft, fragrant and all sorts of other good stuff too ... screwcap

Willunga 100 Shiraz Viognier (95/100 Halliday)

This is a beautiful example of Australia's trendiest blend, with chocolate, cinnamon, dark fruits and a hint of apricot all wrapped up in a viscous mouth feel. Fantastic oak, slippery fruit and fine, powdery tannins...screwcap

Tim Adams Fergus, is damn slurpable, but serious enough to be addictive... **Bonus- buy 6 and get 1 bottle Glatzer Bishop Shiraz FREE**...screwcap

The Willows Shiraz has long been regarded one of the Barossa's best, and best balanced. It's ripe without being over the top and has excellent intensity of fruit, a bit of spice and a long warming finish...

Coriole Redstone 04- It's loaded with intense fruit and finishes with a lovely, silky mouth feel...screwcap

Gemtree Uncut Shiraz 2006 picked up a 95/100 review from Halliday and 1 gold so far and to my mind it's like the excellent 04 vintage, but with more fruit intensity. There's not too much oak, but what there is, is superb and refined, balancing the exuberance of fruit beautifully ... screwcap

Lucky Country's Cabernet is rich, ripe cabernet that packs a big fruit punch, and its length doesn't let up...screwcap
