Volunteering SA is the peak volunteering body in South Australia. The organisation promotes volunteering and plays a key leadership role in advancing volunteering opportunities in South Australia.

The organisation also provides an extensive range of services, support and resources for volunteers and volunteer organisations. In 2006 Volunteering SA organised free training opportunities for volunteers seeking assistance in applying for grants, understanding risk management, and working with people with disabilities.

Volunteering SA maintains links with South Australian regional volunteer services (Fleurieu, Northern & South Coast), as well as national and international volunteering organisations. They provide a database of international volunteering opportunities in fields as diverse as humanitarian aid, community development, environmental conservation, and cross-cultural development and education.
