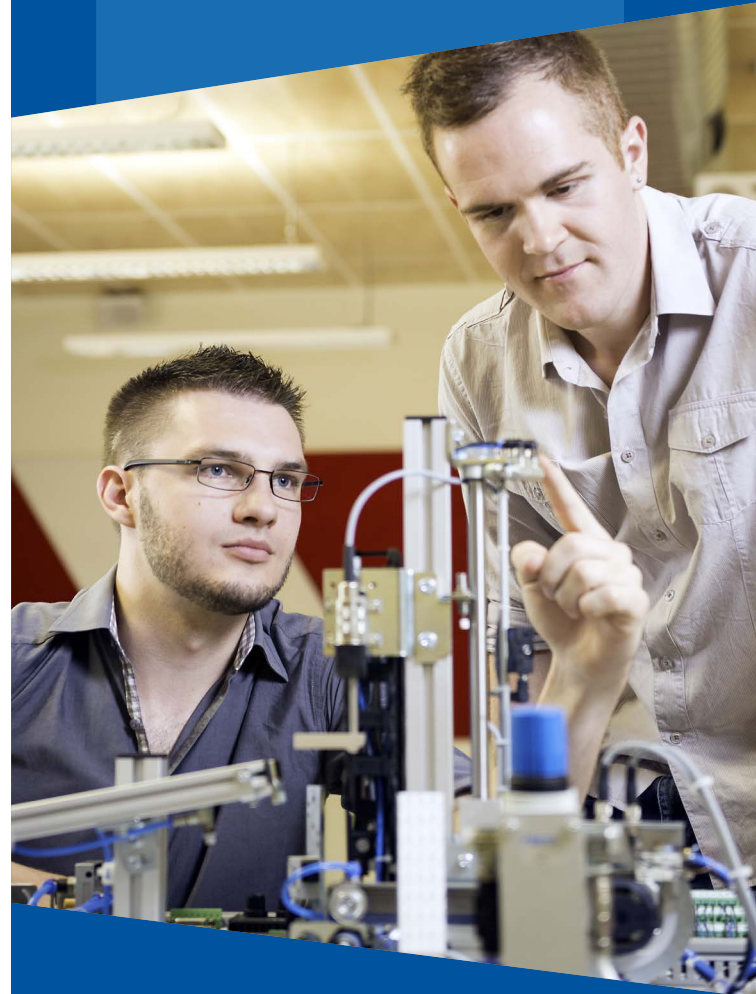

HOW TO BECOME A STUDENT

at the University of South Australia

For undergraduate admission you'll need

- > An Australian Year 12 or equivalent international programs; or
- > A recognised Foundation Studies program; or
- > A SAIBT, Eynesbury, TAFE OR other recognised pathway program.

For postgraduate coursework admission

Usually requires successful completion of:

- > An undergraduate bachelor degree from a recognised higher education institution in Australia; or
- > A degree from an international institution equivalent to an Australian bachelor degree.

HKDSE minimum entry requirement

HKDSE is based on best of 5 subjects (Cat. A only) from any core or elective subject combination where Level 5**=6 points, 5*=5.5; 5=5; 4=4; 3=3; 2=2 and 1=1.

Minimum Level 2 is required for Core subjects.

HKDSE English minimum requirement is Level 4 for equivalent 6.0 IELTS.

Specific subject requirements apply for specified programs.

Minimum English language entry requirement

Please note that many programs have a higher international English language proficiency level, some of which include specific sub-score requirements.

Applicants from countries where English is an official language or who have had recent study experience in English setting may meet our minimum program entry requirements in a number of ways. If you have completed previous study in English you must send certified documentation from the educational institution stating that the language of instruction was in English. The University's international office will consider all applications individually.

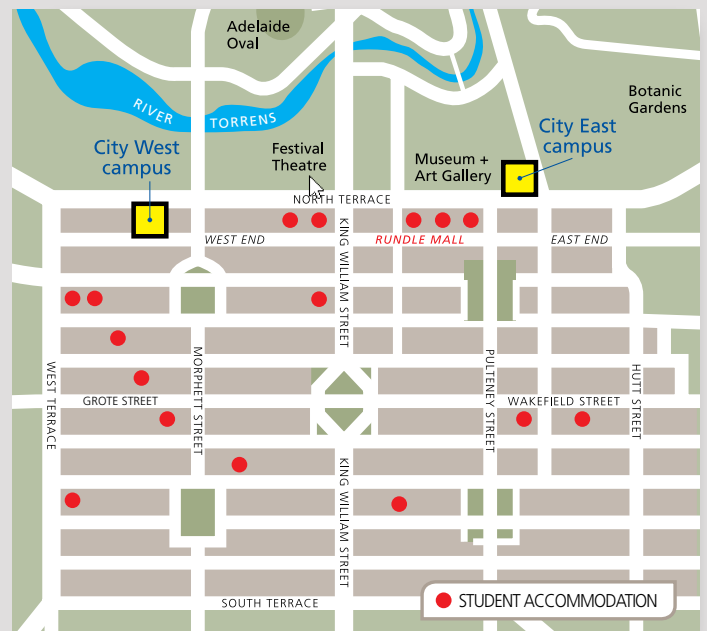
