^ Flight change fees are per person per ticket including GST and applies at time of re-booking. After re-booking the reissue of the ticket must be completed no later than 1 day following the change.

* The unused ticket value for each passenger can be used as payment for a new booking anywhere on the Qantas network within 12 months of original ticket issue. The validity of the new reissued ticket must not exceed the validity of the original ticket. Any applicable flight change fees will apply at the time of rebooking. After rebooking the reissue of the ticket must be completed no later than 1 day following the change.

** **QantasLink regional exceptions** are 14 day advance purchase option in 'Super Saver' family available on QantasLink regional point to point routes only. Fare basis codes are M14ANO, L14ANO, V14ANO. Payment & Ticketing is instant purchase but no later than 14 days before departure. Voluntary re-booking & re-routing prior to day of departure is permitted with a change fee (AUD38.50)^ provided new flight is not booked to a date within the 14 day period after original issue. 'S' and 'R' class may not be available on QantasLink regional routes.
