Dr Sara Charlesworth from the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology will deliver *Understandings of sex discrimination in the workplace: limits and possibilities* in the ninth series of Clare Burton Memorial Lectures around Australia. The lectures commemorate Dr Clare Burton, who passed away suddenly in August 1998. Clare was a leading researcher, public sector administrator, academic, consultant, and writer on employment equity.

Sara is a Senior Research Fellow at the Centre for Applied Social Research at the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology. She has a background in social work, industrial relations, and legal studies, and extensive experience in the areas of equal employment opportunity, work and family policy and practice, and workplace change.

Sara was a member of the academic advisory panel on the recent Human Rights and Equal Opportunity Commission's *Striking the balance: Women, men, work, and care* investigation and is a foundation member of the recently formed *Work + Family Policy Roundtable*. Her research interests centre on gender (in) equality in employment and she is particularly interested in the ways that anti-discrimination and industrial relations regulation is negotiated and implemented at the workplace level.
