DESCRIPTION OF ORIENTATION SESSIONS

Arrival Briefing:

An information session on 'Things I need to know and do' which includes banking, information about orientation program, food and shopping, public transport and safety and emergency contact information.

Accommodation Workshop:

Accommodation Assistance:

Welcome to Australia:
