## Pathway to Master of Occupational Therapy Graduate Entry (IMOG)

### Experience. The Difference.

If you have not covered all the prerequisites in your previous bachelor's degree you can now undertake this pathway program at UniSA.

This Non Award Study Abroad Program consists of three courses in Study Period 2, 2010 (Feb/Mar). Completion of these courses will provide a pathway to the Master of Occupational Therapy (IMOG) for international students, but does not automatically guarantee entry. Students who meet other eligibility criteria as determined by the Program Director (including IELTS of 7.0) and who are granted a conditional offer may undertake this pre-requisites program (Study Abroad Program). Such students must successfully complete all the pre-requisites in order to meet the conditions of their offer and enrol in the Master of Occupational Therapy (IMOG) in Study Period 5, 2010 (July).

Listed below are the prerequisite courses that must be undertaken.

Due to Visa Requirements International Students must be enrolled in at least a 75% study load. Students who already possess any of the above pre-requisites and do not meet the 75% student load are required to undertake additional courses to meet this requirement.

The following 4.5 unit course is highly recommended by the Program Director. Other elective options need to be negotiated with the Program Director.
