DEFINITIONS:

Area + Catalogue Number - A 4-letter area code plus a 4-digit catalogue number make up the course code, e.g. **BIOL 1033**. You can search for courses by using this code.

Class Number - Every class at UniSA has a unique number (e.g. **24813**). You use this number to enrol. Both the **enrolment class** and **related classes** have class numbers.

Enrolment Class - This can be a **lecture (LEC), tutorial (TUT), workshop (WSH) or practical (PRA)**, to name a few examples. It is the first class you must enter when you are enrolling.

Related Classes - (Non-Enrol Classes) These are other required components of the course, and are in addition to the **enrolment class**. They can be one of the following class types - **lecture, tutorial, workshop or practical**, to name a few. In most instances you will have a choice (eg, 1 tutorial to be chosen from 7).

However, in some courses, once you select the **enrolment class** you are automatically enrolled (**Auto-enrol**) in a related class (eg. a particular tutorial or practical at a particular time). The class number will be listed in the Auto-enrol column.

NOTES:

1. The table above shows the full list of courses to be taken by a student undertaking a full-time load solely in this year of the program.
2. Students enrol in all courses for both study periods (Study Period 2 & 5) at the beginning of the year.
3. Some courses have pre-requisites. Students should not enrol in courses where they have not passed the pre-requisite course. If in doubt, please refer to Program Director, Stefan Hornlund on 8302 2228.
4. In study period 5 of third year, students may elect to enrol in four specified courses or undertake the Professional Practice Project. The Professional Practice Project provides students with the opportunity to develop their skills in a practical industry setting and to develop links with potential future employers.
5. Students who have a credit level or better average prior to entry to the final year of the program may take the Honours stream of final year in accordance with University Policy.
6. Credit is granted for approved studies completed in an educational institution or for approved work undertaken or performed in a particular area relevant to the program and within a period which may be specified for that program. Maximum credit allowed is three quarters of the total points for the program.
