4. List the main elements of the project which need to be identified as part of the scoping process
5. The Work Breakdown Structure creates a framework for which activities.
6. What is risk management?

7. What are the critical points on the project life-cycle at which risk management should be applied
8. List key tasks the project manager has to perform as part of the project finalisation process

EXTENDED ANSWER QUESTIONS (15 MARKS EACH)

1. The Project Plan had been described as the project manager's key tool for managing the project.
Describe how the project manager uses the project plan to monitor and control all elements of the project
2. Explain how the project manager defines and manages the scope of the project.
3. Describe the four major processes involved in project risk management and explain one of the tools and techniques used in each of the four processes.

Describe how the project manager should undertake the management of these environments.
