

Police Clearance for IBNU/WBNU students

- The Course Coordinator for Being a Health Professional NURS 1033 & Professional Practice N NURS 1044 will announce and explain at the first internal lecture (Podcast to external students) the need for a Police clearance.
- After the March 31st census date, all students enrolled in the courses Being a Health Professional NURS 1033 & Professional Practice N NURS 1044 will be formally notified by email by the Clinical Placement Unit (CPU) that they require a Police clearance.
- Students are given a 6 month period of time to present their Police clearance to the CPU where it is recorded into the Student Placement System [SPS (previously SONIA)]. During this time students are sent a reminder email from the CPU.
- At the end of that period the CPU will run a report to see which students have not obtained a Police clearance. This report is to be forwarded to the SONM Course Manager.
- A further email is sent by the Course Manager to those students indicating how this will affect their enrolment into Health of Infants, Children and Young People NURS 2022 and any of the ELA courses.
