UniSA

It doesn't take much individually to do plenty for charity together.

Workplace giving through an automatic payroll deduction is a simple, stress-free way to donate regularly to good causes. With over 2,500 staff members at UniSA, together we can make a big difference each fortnight.

An automatic, tax-deductible donation actually lifts your gift.

Just use the coupon attached to pledge an amount to the cause of your choice and UniSA will send it directly to your chosen organisation each pay. Your income tax will then be calculated on a reduced gross salary, giving you an immediate tax benefit. The charity also benefits by receiving your full pre-tax donation automatically.

Here's how far one lunch a fortnight can go.

As an example, let's say you commit the amount of one lunch per fortnight (\$12). If you're in either the 31.5% or 41.5% tax bracket, your contribution would work like this:

| Fortnightly pre-tax contribution | Nett fortnightly cost to staff member | Nett annual cost to staff member | Annual contribution to charity |
|----------------------------------|---------------------------------------|----------------------------------|--------------------------------|
| \$12 (31.5%) | \$8.22 | \$214 | \$312 |
| \$12 (41.5%) | \$7.02 | \$183 | \$312 |

The same benefits apply to one off gifts. At tax time you will claim the total amount of donations on your annual return.

Computer@home scheme.

Donated desktop computers are refurbished and installed with basic software and a modem, then provided to financially disadvantaged students free of charge for home use. At the cost of \$300 per computer, this scheme has an immediate response on the life of a student.

For context, \$300 is equal to a pre-tax contribution of \$12 per fortnight, which would cost you less than \$9 of your take home pay.



Scholarships.

UniSA Scholarships provide crucial support to many academically able but financially or educationally disadvantaged students, as well as those from isolated locations, and academic high achievers. The funds help with the array of expenses associated with a university education including relocation and accommodation, travel, textbooks, technology and course fees.

Scholarship values can vary from \$1,000 to \$20,000 per annum.

Library.

As one of the state's greatest educational resources, the UniSA Library needs to update constantly. The average cost of a book is \$100. So for everyone who donates \$100, a bookplate will be proudly placed in the front of the new addition. Alternatively, donors can support key research collections or electronic resources by nominating this preference.

As an indication, \$100 is equal to a pre-tax contribution of \$4 per fortnight, which would cost you less than \$2.75 of your take home pay.
