Applicants seeking entry to the program will have:

- Completed a three-year Bachelor degree from a recognised higher education institution in media arts, VFX or a related discipline

or

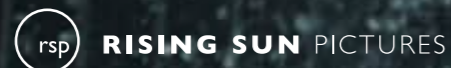
- Completed an Advanced Diploma in Screen and Media or equivalent from an accredited, registered training organisation.

All applicants must submit a showreel of their own work and a curriculum vitae outlining their relevant experience.

Graduate Certificate in Dynamic Effects and Lighting

The Graduate Certificate in Dynamic Effects and Lighting is a 12-week intensive program that immerses students in a simulated studio environment, while providing the necessary theoretical and practical skills to produce complex visual effects for film and screen. Students will learn 3D visual effects techniques such as dynamic effects (particle-based simulations such as explosions, water effects, textural effects, clouds); procedurally generated environments (such as cities, beaches and forests); and computer generated lighting applications.

Graduate Certificate in Compositing and Tracking

The Graduate Certificate in Compositing and Tracking is a 12-week intensive program that immerses students in a simulated studio environment, while familiarising students with professional practice in compositing and tracking,

and providing the theory, skills and techniques to produce industry-standard visual effects based film sequences. Students experience hands-on training in core skills required by entry-level visual effects artists, and the program gives practical insight into career strategies and employment prospects locally, nationally and internationally.

Within each graduate certificate, students gain exposure to professional practice standards, through learning in a production studio, and using industry standard software under the supervision of experienced visual effects artists. Upon completion of the programs, graduates will have a clear understanding of what it takes to succeed in this highly competitive and rewarding industry, as well as an invaluable connection to one of Australia's leading visual effects companies. Together, these two graduate certificates provide students with the required skills and knowledge to seek and gain employment as an entry-level visual effects artist.
