This includes a catered morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea; the aforementioned plenary and keynote presentations (from world-leadings scholars in educational SFL); the announcement of the MAK Halliday Prize (an international book prize awarded for the most significant scholarly monograph recently published in SFL); and a book launch in the evening.
