Glossary

This study makes reference to terminology that can be interpreted differently based on methodological orientation. The following section defines the meaning of these terms in this study. The glossary is divided into two categories: Child Protection and Conversation Analysis (CA), terms are listed in alphabetical order within each section. For specific examples of these terms, see 'Linguistic/Interactional Analysis of Grooming Behaviours.'

Child Protection

Age, sex, and location (ASL)

Text chat commonly features solicitations of age, sex, and location, usually at the start of an exchange. The acronym 'ASL' is generally used to seek this information.

Assessing risk/probing vulnerabilities

The language and interactional behaviours used during online grooming that are associated with 'assessing risk', consists of perpetrators' asking questions of the decoy to judge whether their chat participant's environment could jeopardise their activities. Perpetrators also probe the target's vulnerabilities through personal self-disclosures (see entry below).

Child Sexual Abuse

Child Sexual Abuse (CSA) is, "any act that exposes a child or young person to, or involves a child or young person in, sexual activities that: they do not understand, they do not or cannot consent to, are not accepted by the community and are unlawful" (Australian Government, 2025).

Decoy

A decoy in this study is a person who was working as a volunteer with Perverted Justice and posing as a child for the purpose of obtaining enough information to apprehend child sexual perpetrators. Their interactions with online grooming perpetrators are found in transcripts from the Perverted Justice website archives. The age range portrayed by the decoys was usually between 10 –15 years of age.

Online grooming

Online grooming involves an adult building a relationship with a child for the explicit purpose of sexual abuse and exploitation via technology (Chiu & Quayle, 2022).

Perpetrator

A perpetrator is an adult who intentionally and deliberately enacts behaviours to groom a child for the purpose of sexual abuse. A perpetrator often visits social media and gaming sites to locate potential victims and may connect in an online environment with vulnerable children and young people already known to them (Ey, 2024).

Transition Sexual Post

A Transition Sexual Post is the post in a conversational exchange where the conversation changes orientation to sexual.

Conversation Analysis

Advice-giving to promote protective stance

Advice-giving is used by perpetrators to portray a protective stance and reassure the chat participant. For example, "You shouldn't do that as it's not safe."

Affiliative behaviours

Affiliative behaviours comprise positive assessments (compliments), advice-giving to promote protective stance, apologies, and negative assessments (criticising others and self-deprecation). The intention is to form social and emotional bonds with the chat participant. In this project, perpetrators attempted to portray themselves as protective and/or caring.

Apologies

An apology is a linguistic expression employed to show politeness (Watts, 2003). A perpetrator may offer an apology to win favour with the target and present themselves in a positive light.

Closings

Closings in CA terminology are the collaborative routines used to end a conversation. They typically occur before separation from social interaction and contain topic termination, leave-taking and the termination of contact.

Compliments

A compliment is a positive assessment that participants pay one another to create a positive environment for interaction. In this study the perpetrator complimented the chat participant to make them feel special, nurturing continued interaction to facilitate later abuse (Williams et al., 2013).

Criticising others

Criticising others is a form of negative assessment. This linguistic behaviour is carried out with the intention of isolating the chat participant.

Emotional blackmail or threat

Emotional blackmail is a form of manipulation where a perpetrator targets the chat participants' feelings to control them. Perpetrators used threats through announcements and requests to instil fear and feelings of guilt and obligation. These threatening actions are formed from a conditional logic that may result in negative consequences for the recipient (Hepburn & Potter, 2011).

'Getting to know you' behaviours

'Getting to know you' behaviours in this study are those where the participants interacted to establish rapport before grooming intentions were revealed through the transition sexual post. 'Getting to know you' sequences are seen as part of the organised co-constructed conversational trajectory of the unfolding events. There are various forms of 'getting to know you' behaviours that are categorised under different forms of self-disclosure, as listed below.

Negative assessments

In CA terminology, negative assessments may apply to the language perpetrators use to criticise or defame the target's loved ones or criticise the target. In this study, negative assessments comprise the criticism by the chat participants of one another, or other people not in the chat. This category also includes self-deprecation.

Non-personal self-disclosure

Non-personal self-disclosures are of a non-personal/non-private nature, for example, sharing information about entertainment, hobbies, school, work, daily activities and technical matters. They are categorised under 'getting to know you' behaviours because they are appropriate for the social context.

Openings

The openings of a conversation typically constitute a greeting sequence and tend to be followed by a 'how are you?' sequence. Openings usually consist of contact initiation, greetings and topic initiation.

Personal self-disclosure

Personal self-disclosures are a type of self-disclosure that are linguistically designed by chat participants, but mainly by the perpetrator, to access personal or private information from the target that may be deemed inappropriate for a child to give to an adult stranger in an online environment. The perpetrator asks these types of questions to assess the risk or probe the vulnerabilities of the target. Similar to non-personal self-disclosures, personal self-disclosures can then be classified as prompted, unprompted or unprompted sequence-initial self-disclosure (new topic initiation).

Prompted self-disclosure

Prompted self-disclosure is any information given in response to a direct question (Haugh & Carbaugh, 2015).

Rapport building

Rapport building in grooming interactions is the process of establishing and developing relationships. It is achieved by utilising small talk, openings, closings and 'getting to know you' behaviours. Rapport building in the social actions of online grooming includes gaining the victim's trust, that may lead to sexual/romantic conversation.

Self-deprecation

Self-deprecation is a form of negative assessment. For example, when participants are critical of themselves, or when they minimise themselves, their abilities or their achievements.

Self-disclosure

Self-disclosure relates to a participant disclosing something about themselves to the other participant. Various types of self-disclosure are used by chat participants, but mainly by perpetrators in this study, to elicit information from the target (Tudini, 2025).

Small talk

Small talk is a category for varieties of conversational interaction or chitchat that occurs in many settings. It includes openings, closings and 'getting to know you' behaviours through non-personal self-disclosures.

Unprompted self-disclosure

Unprompted self-disclosure is information which is volunteered by topic relevance (Haugh & Carbaugh, 2015).

Unprompted sequence-initial self-disclosure (or new topic initiation)

Unprompted sequence-initial self-disclosure occurs when participants volunteer information about themselves by initiating a change of topic (Strambi & Tudini, 2020).

Positive assessments

Assessments in CA terminology are "turns which provide an evaluation" (Liddicoat, 2021, p. 149) and may be positive or negative in nature (Heritage, 1985). Positive assessments in online grooming are seen in compliments that the participants pay one another in text chats.

Executive Summary

Background

Traditional sexual grooming has now significantly shifted with children's increased engagement with the internet. Online grooming involves an adult building a relationship with a child for the explicit purpose of sexual abuse and exploitation via technology (Chiu & Quayle, 2022), usually through text chat available in gaming platforms or social media. Using Conversation Analysis (CA) techniques, this project aims to provide insights into how perpetrators gain children's trust and establish relationships with them during preliminary online interaction, prior to moving to sexually oriented online talk. By using CA, this project identifies the recurrent language and interactional behaviours of perpetrators to contribute knowledge about the online grooming process, where grooming 'does not necessarily involve any sexual activity or even discussion of sexual activity' (Victorian Government, 2014) prior to the conversation transitioning to sexual talk.

Research Aims

- identifies typical and recurrent patterns of interactional behaviours by offenders at initial contact and during preliminary non-sexual interactions with adult decoys posing as children online;
- provides the community and police with new linguistic indicators of perpetrators' behaviour to promote more productive monitoring, identification and apprehension of suspects;
- 3) provides a research-based definition of the language of online grooming for police and law courts;
- 4) creates a previously unavailable working dataset of perpetrators' preliminary non-sexual interactional behaviours to inform child protection and prevention responses.

Research Questions

- 1) Do suspects use similar recurrent language and interactional behaviours for online grooming of children at the initial non-sexual stages of exchanges?
- 2) Can the application of CA techniques combined with frequency counts reveal unique features of grooming through precise exemplification, definition and categorisation of typical online language and conversational actions deployed by suspects during nonsexual grooming?

In the process of identifying the non-sexual components of interactions it became necessary to devise a process for identifying at what point the conversation transitioned into one which had a sexual nature. As such, a new research question arose from the process:

3) What language and/or conversational action do perpetrators use to transition from non-sexual to sexually oriented interaction?

Methodology

Conversation analysis techniques identify how people produce, organise and interpret talk to achieve specific underlying conversational actions which are not always obvious to participants during interaction (Sacks et al., 1974). CA can reveal how speakers organise their

talk as a social achievement, which they construct jointly with other speakers. CA is now commonly applied to online contexts, including gaming and social media contexts where children are involved (Tudini, 2025). Their application to a variety of children's online interaction contexts has also provided important insights into young participants' interactional design and ability to adapt linguistically to online interaction (Danby et al., 2018; Davidson, 2012). Given the paucity of online grooming research where CA is applied (Pfister, 2017), this project used CA to provide insights on linguistic and interactional factors which allow groomers to build rapport with children, for future prevention of child sexual exploitation.

Drawing on chat transcripts obtained in the Perverted Justice archives (Perverted Justice, 2019), the research team collected the most recent transcripts available (n=100) to ensure linguistic currency and selected those where participants engaged in a sufficient amount of non-sexual rapport building behaviours before transitioning to sexually oriented conversation. Exclusions were related to overtly sexual screen names of perpetrators or sexual talk in the first 12 posts of the chat, which left a sample of 94 transcripts, on which most of the transition sexual post analysis was completed. The ten longest exchanges to transition sexual post amounted to nearly half of the total non-sexual rapport building stages of the transcripts (48.2%), which was considered an appropriate sample for micro-analysis using CA in Stage 2 of the project.

Research Findings

Stage 1 - Identifying the Transition Sexual Post

To be able to focus analysis on rapport building stages of each chat exchange, it was necessary to establish the point at which the online conversation became sexually oriented. Each member of the research team, and in the final stages, a linguist external to the team, analysed a sample of 10 transcripts to ascertain the post or sequences which steered the chat in a sexual direction. Analysis found that transition sexual posts had a) various linguistic formats and b) different levels of sexual explicitness. Linguistic formats ranged from questions and announcements to compliments and requests. These formats ranged from sexually explicit language (e.g., ever seen a cock?) to more subtle suggestive conversational actions (e.g., so you think you can handle me?). Additionally, the process of identification of Transition Sexual Posts demonstrated the varying ways in which perpetrators shifted conversation towards sexual goals but also highlighted the many questionable posts that appeared before a clear transition could be marked, providing a series of extracts for deeper analysis.

Stage 2 - Identifying most common rapport building behaviours

Findings indicate that perpetrators initiated small talk more often than decoys. Specifically, the small talk included opening the conversation, closing the conversation, introducing a new topic and non-personal self-disclosures, which were a regular part of the 'getting to know you' interactions with the decoy. This finding suggests that the perpetrator tended to dominate the conversation more than the decoy, which is a sign of a power imbalance between the two participants. The perpetrators also tended to ask questions more often than the decoy, which mirrors the findings on initiation of small talk. Questions often revolved around entertainment, hobbies, daily activities, technical matters, work, school/college, food and meals, and offering the interlocutor the choice of topic.

Limitations

A recent systematic review by members of this research team (Tudini et al., under review) revealed there is limited research on a) non-sexual online interactions b) micro-level discourse features, as is done using CA or discourse analysis (DA) approaches and c) involving genuine children, with most studies based on police and vigilantes acting as child decoys. Online interactions with adult decoys are unlikely to entail the use of the same language and interactional resources as those with genuine children in the same contexts. This is because while perpetrators' language and interactional behaviour is the same across contexts involving children or adult decoys, responses are likely to vary. Additional variation is likely according to the age of children, where younger children under 12 are likely to respond and behave differently from older children. Other linguistic studies in this area confirm the importance of analysing conversations between online predators and genuine children rather than police decoys (Chiang & Grant, 2019).

While research using authentic datasets involving perpetrators chatting with genuine children would provide important insights on grooming trajectories in online conversation, the cooperation of law enforcement is required. Law enforcement cooperation is, however, reliant on police resources to obtain and de-identify perpetrator and genuine child transcripts. While valuable data has been identified through the Perverted Justice archives and used fruitfully in the current research, the original project was intended to include participants consisting of perpetrators and police decoys rather than vigilante child decoys. However, despite our efforts, the research team was unable to obtain approval to access data from four police jurisdictions (SA, QLD, VIC, AFP) and the SA courts. For this reason, the team relied on the Perverted Justice archives for its investigation as the data involved perpetrators and decoys pretending to be children, as intended in the original project. While perpetrator language and interactional features are authentic, decoys' responses are less so, because genuine children are likely to respond differently in accordance with their age. For example, the aggression by perpetrators toward children rather than decoys may be explained by decoys offering less resistance than a genuine child who may feel unsure or unsafe in the reviewed interactions. Further research using perpetrator-genuine child transcriptions can provide greater insights into manipulation tactics.

Nonetheless perpetrator-decoy interactions are a valid object of study for the purpose of identifying the conversational behaviours of perpetrators to enact rapport-building in non-sexual online grooming. The transition sexual posts were initiated by perpetrators rather than decoys; hence findings related to this interactional and linguistic turning point in the interaction are valuable for the prevention of child sexual exploitation.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the following strategies are implemented to prevent online child sexual grooming and online child sexual abuse and exploitation:

Community campaign to educate parents on the conversational tactics of online sexual perpetrators. For example, children and protective adults need to learn to gauge whether a chat partner is dominating the online interaction by asking excessive questions, frequently changing topic and disclosing personal information to prompt similar self-disclosures in the child.

- Educational programs, such as protective behaviours programs, child protection programs, media literacy, and cybersafety, need to incorporate patterns of behaviour used by perpetrators to groom children online (e.g., as outlined in the first point as well as moving the conversation from a public to a more private forum, requesting multiple photos, or giving sexualised compliments).
- Software platforms should detect when language transitions to a sexual nature to then alert the child or young person to immediately cease engagement and report/block the offender. This could be implemented by warning systems facilitated by AI.
- Media providers are made accountable for social media interactions to monitor sexual exploitation of minors.
- Training for police decoys includes understanding and recognising transition sexual posts.
- Review of funding models to facilitate research collaboration between law enforcement staff involved in the protection of children from online groomers and research teams who are engaged in relevant research.
- A research focus on online interactions between genuine children and perpetrators is required to understand how children of different ages respond to online grooming, and to train police decoys to imitate children's behaviours in this context.
- Further research is required on how to distinguish genuine rapport building behaviour from grooming related behaviours online.

Report

Background

Childhood sexual abuse is a serious global phenomenon which is increasingly being perpetrated online (Finkelhor et al., 2022). Recent research has found that more than 300 million children globally are being affected by online child sexual exploitation and abuse (Salter et al., 2024). This first of its kind global index data explored 125 representative studies across 57 countries. It found that one in eight (12.6%) children have been victim to non-consensual taking, sharing or receiving of sexual images and videos. The same number of children (12.5%) were subjected to online sexual solicitation, such as unwanted sexual talk, unwanted sexual questions and unwanted sexual act requests by adults or other youths (Salter et al., 2024).

The Australian Child Maltreatment Study (ACMS), a nationally representative crosssectional epidemiological survey with 8503 Australians aged 16 years or older, found that 17.7% of participants reported online sexual solicitation by an adult. For the purpose of that study, sexual solicitation was defined as 'a request made online by an adult (aged 18 or more) to a child (aged under 18) to provide sexual information, conversation, or images' (Walsh et al., 2025, p. 2). Forty-nine percent of those who reported experiencing online solicitation stated that it occurred 2-5 times (49.3 %) before the age of 18 years, 18.1% (n = 272) reported between 11-50 times; 14% (n = 201) reported once only, and 5% reported more than 50 episodes (Walsh et al., 2025). Just over two-thirds (67.3%) of victims experienced their first incident of online sexual solicitation between the age of 12-15 years, 20.5 % were aged 16-17 years, 9.2% were aged 11-12 years and 3% were aged under 10 years (Walsh et al., 2025). The majority of adult perpetrators (86.7%) were unknown to the child, 11.8% were known adults "(an adult the child knew who was not a parent, adult family member, or an institutional adult)", 1% were institutional caregivers, and 0.5% were parents or adult family members (Walsh et al., 2025). The anonymous nature of the internet facilitates online sexual solicitation which often involves online grooming (Forni et al., 2020).

What is online sexual grooming?

Sexual grooming is the deceptive process used by sexual abusers to facilitate sexual contact with a minor while simultaneously avoiding detection. Prior to the commission of the sexual abuse, the would-be sexual abuser may select a victim, gain access to and isolate the minor, develop trust with the minor and often their guardians, community, and youth-serving institutions, and desensitize the minor to sexual content and physical contact. Post-abuse, the offender may use maintenance strategies on the victim to facilitate future sexual abuse and/or to prevent disclosure (Winters et al., 2022, p. 993).

Child sexual grooming is a multifaceted process and is not limited to only grooming the child. According to Winters et al. (2022), there are four broad forms of sexual grooming. These are grooming the child, self, family, and community/institutional members. Sexual grooming behaviours will depend on who is being groomed and in what context (i.e., in-person versus online). Sexually grooming the child involves the offender employing grooming behaviours toward the potential victim. Grooming behaviours can include communicating with or attempting to develop a relationship or emotional connection with the child, gift giving, special

attention, building trust, and non-sexual touching. It can also include coercion, manipulation, blackmailing, threatening, blame and sexual touching.

Self-grooming consists of the offenders psychologically priming themselves in an attempt to justify, minimise, or deny their behaviours (Winters et al., 2022). Offenders may try to convince themselves that the child is a willing participant and wants to engage in sexual activity with them, or that the sexual activity they are engaging in with the child is low level or harmless to the child, or that what they are doing is not sexual.

Familial grooming comprises of gaining the trust of family members to portray themselves as a respectable and trustworthy person in an attempt to obtain access to the victim and decrease the likelihood of suspicion (Winters et al., 2022). Offenders may seek vulnerable families, build a relationship with them, befriend them, and offer to 'help'. The help may begin with supporting the parent/caregiver emotionally, financially, or with daily chores or activities. The help however is designed to create situations for the offender to obtain time alone with the child.

Finally, an offender may groom an institution or the community by establishing themselves as a valued and respected staff or community member (Winters et al., 2022). Offenders will often go above and beyond to help and support children. Much like familial grooming strategies, offenders will come across as caring, helpful and supportive adults. Offenders often seek careers or volunteer positions that provide access to children (e.g., teachers, social workers, child health workers, coaches, scout leaders). This position not only places them in a role where they can easily access children, but they are in a position of authority where children and their families will likely trust them.

Sexual grooming can occur in-person or online (Winters et al., 2020). Sexual grooming that traditionally took place in-person and involved face-to-face interactions between offenders, their victims, their families and other adults, has significantly shifted with the internet. The internet allows offenders to entrench themselves into a victim's life by enabling consistent contact via multiple channels. Online grooming involves an adult building a relationship with a child for the explicit purpose of sexual abuse and exploitation via technology (Chiu & Quayle, 2022).

Models of sexual grooming

According to Winters et al. (2020), there are five stages offenders use during their grooming process. These are:

- Selecting a victim; offenders usually look for vulnerable children which may be relative to a number of criteria. These are the child's size and age, their personal characteristics, such as being overly compliant or trusting, lonely or isolated, with low-self- esteem, troubled, needy, unloved, estranged from family, or unsupervised. Or their family circumstances, such as coming from a dysfunctional family, or a family with complex needs, trauma or adversity (Winters et al., 2020). In the online environment, perpetrators often troll popular social media sites and gaming sites to find potential victims and may also connect online with vulnerable children and young people they already know (Ey, 2024).
- Gaining access to and isolating the victim; offenders will often seek employment or volunteer in organizations where they can easily access children, groom the family to

gain access to the child, disconnect the child's relationships by breaking down the child's confidence in their families and peers, and establish routines or generate opportunities for them to be alone with the child (Winters et al., 2020). The online environment provides opportunities for both predators known and not known to the family. Through the internet, offenders can contact child victims in virtual spaces, such as social media, gaming apps, and through other digital platforms (Leclerc et al., 2021; Westlake, 2020). Most Australian children aged 8-17 years (94%) have access to Wi-Fi at home, 68% have internet connection on their mobile phone, 51% have internet connection at school, and 31% and 29% respectively have internet access in public spaces or at their work (Telstra Foundation, 2024). Most Australian children (77%) aged 8-17 years are well connected through ownership of digital devices, with smartphones (86%) and laptops (74%) being the most popular devices, followed by smart TVs (63%), personal tablets (53%), and game consoles (53%) (Telstra Foundation, 2024). This suggests that accessing youth online would be easy. Offenders often initially access the child on gaming or social media platforms and then progress to other platforms such as Snapchat, Tik Tok, or Instagram to avoid detection by protective adults in the child's environment and by law enforcement (Ringenberg et al., 2022)

- Developing trust with the child and others (e.g., caretakers, community members); offenders present as nice, likeable, and charming, and strive to develop a good reputation within their community. They are sometimes seen as a 'pillar of the community' (Winters et al., 2020). Developing trust is a central part of the grooming process and can occur both offline and online. The establishment of 'secret keeping' usually starts with small secrets such as giving something to the child that the child desires (i.e., paying for game or music subscriptions) and asking them to keep it secret (Blalock & Bourke, 2022). The perpetrator typically presents as a nonthreatening individual with whom the child can talk and spend time (Ringenberg et al., 2022). They engage with the child relative to their age (i.e., behave like their peers) for example, playing games with younger children or talking about sexual matters with teenagers. The online environment makes it easier for perpetrators to lie about their age, gender, appearance and general identity, and to use fake pictures, profiles and videos to ignite the child's interest (Ey, 2024; Ringenberg et al., 2022).
- Pesensitising the child to sexual content, physical touch, or sexual behaviour; in person, offenders may physically touch the child in a seemingly innocent and non-sexual way and increase the touching, gradually making the touch more sexual (Winters et al., 2020). In person and online offenders may ask questions about the child's sexual experiences or relationships, share their own sexual experiences, give sexual compliments, use inappropriate sexual language or sexual jokes, or show the child sexually explicit material such as pornography, and some may ask for explicit sexual material from the child (Ey, 2024; Ringenberg et al., 2022; Winters et al., 2020). They may introduce an online sexual exchange over webcams, such as masturbating in front of the camera and encouraging the child to engage in similar sexual acts. These 'fantasy plays' by offenders are strategized to facilitate arousal and frame the sexual abuse and exploitation as mutually enjoyable cybersex. In the online environment, some sexual perpetrators almost immediately make their sexual intentions known to the child. (Ringenberg et al., 2022).

■ Post abuse maintenance behaviours; offenders will heighten the need for secrecy and may use manipulations such as expressing their love for the child, rewarding the child for their silence, persuading the child that the abuse was normal, or threatening or blaming the child (Winters et al., 2020). In an online environment, offenders can threaten to share a child's sexually explicit text or images. This action controls the child who fears that they will be found out by family and friends, or worse, that their images will go viral.

Impacts of online grooming

As expected, sexual grooming most often leads to children being sexually abused (Helgheim & Frøyland, 2025; Jeglic & Winters, 2025; Jeglic et al., 2023; Winters et al., 2024), with some studies finding that 100% (Jeglic & Winters, 2025), and 99% (Winters et al., 2024) of children who were sexually abused were groomed by their perpetrator.

Impacts from child sexual abuse are immense and often lifelong. Research suggests that child sexual abuse is associated with psychopathology, including mood disorders, personality disorders, anxiety disorders, post-traumatic stress disorder, psychosis, suicidality, eating disorders, and substance use (Wolf & Pruitt, 2019). Some research reported an association between child sexual abuse and brain development, stating that child sexual abuse can impact the brain structurally, functionally, and in terms of connectivity of the brain (Wolf & Pruitt, 2019).

The Australian Child Maltreatment study found that those who suffered child sexual abuse had strong associations with health risk behaviours in the past 12 months prior to the survey. These include smoking, binge drinking, cannabis dependence, obesity, self-harming, and suicide attempts (Lawrence et al., 2023). Additionally, children who have been groomed often suffer lifelong emotional impacts such as feelings of shame, guilt, embarrassment, betrayal, powerlessness, and exploitation as well as causing the development of insecure attachment (Wolf & Pruitt, 2019). Epigenetically, child sexual abuse can impact pubertal timing, and neuroendocrine, autonomic nervous systems and the immune system (Wolf & Pruitt, 2019).

Child sexual abuse can also impact survivors' sexual functioning with some survivors reporting sexual dysfunction (Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse, 2017; Wolf & Pruitt, 2019), heightened sexual activity (Wolf & Pruitt, 2019), sexual avoidance or aversion (Wolf & Pruitt, 2019), and engagement in harmful, sexually promiscuous or sexually abuse behaviours (Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse, 2017; Wolf & Pruitt, 2019).

Community understandings of online grooming

Australian research conducted with parents, educators, significant adults in a caring role (i.e., grandparents, aunties/uncles, babysitter), health professionals (GPs, school counsellors), and other community members that explored community awareness, perceptions, and attitudes toward online child exploitation, found that while the community had awareness of what online child sexual exploitation (CSE) entailed, it was perceived that minimal incidents of CSE were occurring in Australia (Australian Centre to Counter Child Exploitation, 2020). When participants were asked to list their top five greatest concerns in relation to online safety in Australia, only 11% identified online predators or paedophiles, and only 3% mentioned online grooming. Most participants were unaware of how perpetrators seek out victims, e.g., social media and gaming apps, and how quickly the grooming process can occur (Australian

Centre to Counter Child Exploitation, 2020). Research in Malaysia exploring parents' awareness of online predators and cyber grooming deterrence found that nine of the 19 parents were not familiar with the term online grooming (Dorasamy et al., 2021).

Research with 1,133 United States college students that retrospectively explored their internet interaction, experiences of online sexual solicitation or grooming, and their perceptions of the experience found that 23% (n=263) of participants had experienced online grooming by an adult. Of these, 47% (n=124) described the nature of the relationship as flirting or dating. Interactions included receiving compliments, discussing school, interests, likes and dislikes, relationships and the perpetrator mentoring them about life. The majority of participants did not describe their online relationships as negative or abusive. Furthermore, 100 participants reported meeting with the adult perpetrator in person as a minor, with 51 reporting that they engaged in consensual sexual intercourse (Greene-Colozzi et al., 2020). The perceived positivity of the grooming relationships suggests that these students are not aware of the serious risks and impacts of grooming.

Research Aims

Given community perceptions described in the previous section, the current research sheds light on the subtle language and machinery of interaction that is deployed by perpetrators to gain children's trust and establish relationships with them during preliminary online interaction, prior to moving to sexually oriented online talk. By using conversation analysis techniques, this research identifies the recurrent language and interactional behaviours of predators, to contribute knowledge about the online grooming process, where grooming 'does not necessarily involve any sexual activity or even discussion of sexual activity' (Victorian Government, 2014).

Findings aim to inform community, protective adults, school curriculum, and children of online grooming behaviour as well as facilitate early identification of offenders by police by informing the definition of non-sexual online grooming, contributing to the protection of children. Specifically, this project:

- identifies typical and recurrent patterns of interactional behaviours by offenders at initial contact and during preliminary non-sexual interactions with adult decoys posing as children online;
- provides the community and police with new linguistic indicators of perpetrators' behaviour to promote more productive monitoring, identification and apprehension of suspects;
- 3) provides a research-based definition of the language of online grooming for police and law courts;
- 4) creates a previously unavailable working dataset of perpetrators' preliminary non-sexual interactional behaviours to inform child protection and prevention responses.

Research Questions

- 1) Do suspects use similar recurrent language and interactional behaviours for online grooming of children at the initial non-sexual stages of exchanges?
- 2) Can the application of CA techniques combined with frequency counts reveal unique features of grooming through precise exemplification, definition and categorisation of

typical online language and conversational actions deployed by suspects during non-sexual grooming?

In the process of identifying the non-sexual components of interactions, it became necessary to devise a process for identifying at what point the conversation transitioned into one which had a sexual nature. As such, a new research question arose from the process:

3) What language and/or conversational action do perpetrators use to transition from non-sexual to sexually oriented interaction?

Methodology

What is Conversation Analysis (CA)?

Conversation analysis (CA) techniques have been used since the 1960s to identify how people produce, organise and interpret talk to achieve specific underlying conversational actions which are not always obvious to participants during interaction (Sacks et al., 1974). CA can reveal how speakers organise their talk as a social achievement, which they construct jointly with other speakers. The first landmark publications by Harvey Sacks, Emanuel Schegloff and Gail Jefferson, founders of conversation analysis, have had enormous impact in Applied Linguistics and in research more generally¹. These now highly influential analytical techniques were originally developed to examine face-to-face and phone conversation but have since been applied in a variety of social and institutional interactional contexts, including health (Bloch & Leydon, 2019), cross-gender violence (Stokoe, 2010), and sexual violence (Kitzinger & Frith, 1999).

CA is used for in-depth systematic analysis of talk in everyday naturally occurring social and institutional interaction. It provides a robust methodological foundation to investigate new forms of interaction in online settings, including institutional and educational sites (Giles et al., 2015). It allows researchers to gain insights from an interactional perspective into how grooming is accomplished through online chat. These insights would be unavailable without attention to how participants build rapport turn by turn (or post by post), including the interactional resources that they deploy in the online setting. One of the distinctive features of the online setting is that participants are geographically dispersed, hence conversational topic and language are affected.

Researchers have previously applied this set of techniques to online social interaction, including text chat between language learning partners (Tudini, 2010; Tudini & Liddicoat, 2017; Tudini & Strambi, 2017), and children in gaming and social media contexts (Tudini, 2025). The application of CA to a variety of children's online interaction contexts has also provided important insights into young participants' interactional design and ability to adapt linguistically to online interaction (Danby et al., 2018; Davidson, 2012). As noted by Wager et al. (2018), key initial grooming stages include friendship formation, relationship formation, and securing the target's trust. CA is able to provide insights on linguistic and interactional factors which allow groomers to construct these stages. This is essential for future prevention of child sexual exploitation.

CA permits the examination of online grooming as an interactional accomplishment. CA is based on the notion that interaction is the mutually oriented and normatively organised structure which attends to the unfolding interaction between participants. Interactants accomplish actions through the "underlying norms and practices that make interaction the orderly thing that it is" (Sidnell, 2016, p. 2), whether this is turn-taking, repairing turns (e.g., silences, overlaps), storytelling, or positive assessments (compliments). CA seeks to describe and analyse these 'underlying norms and practices' in different contexts, such as the online grooming environment in this study. In keeping with conversation analytic principles and the requirement for unmotivated looking, the complete set of online exchanges was initially analysed by researchers with no a priori expectations (Antaki et al., 2003; Balaman & Sert, 2017; Firth & Wagner, 1997) and subsequently discussed. Recurrent language and behaviours were also noted during the process of identification of Transition Sexual Posts and rapport building interactions leading up to these. Specifically, the excerpts for this study were chosen because they occur in initial rapport building interactions, prior to the exchange transitioning to sexually oriented talk. This approach respects a basic premise of conversation analysis that talk is context-shaped as well as context-renewing (Seedhouse, 2004, p. 14). Specifically, as Schegloff (1987) noted, "social action done through talk is organized and orderly not, or not only, as a matter of rule or as a statistical regularity, but on a case by case, action by action basis" (p. 102).

CA applied to online talk

CA methodology is well suited to investigate the implicit ways that participants organise social action during conversation and social interactions (Kasper & Wagner, 2014). The use of CA to examine online interactions has recently received increased attention from conversation analysts (Giles et al., 2015; Meredith, 2017; Tudini, 2025) and it may offer insights into the linguistic and interactional patterns of perpetrators when they communicate and build rapport with children within online environments. Gaining an understanding of the linguistic and interactional strategies used by perpetrators at the initial stages of online grooming can help educate children, parents and other protective adults to keep children safe online. As we cannot assume that children and protective adults are able to recognise online grooming in the pre-sexual, rapport building phase, project findings may be able to inform broader CSE prevention programming and online safety strategies.

In their review on the application of CA to online talk, Paulus et al. (2016) remark on the growing call to refrain from explicit comparison between face-to-face and online talk and begin to acknowledge online interactions as "social practices in their own right" (Lamerichs & te Molder, 2003, p. 461). This argument is increasingly voiced by researchers, based not only on the growing ubiquity of online interactions, but also on the inherent affordances and constraints of different technological platforms (Berglund, 2009; Tudini, 2018). Helm and Dooly (2017) have extended the argument that in high complexity platforms with many modalities of simultaneous communication (e.g., text chat, audio, video, emojis) there is a need for adaptation of CA to fit the online discourse characteristics.

While the project team did not have access to all modalities in the transcripts, as only written conversations including emoticons, acronyms and abbreviations are available, the constraints of the online environment were taken into account. This is because online text chat is a form of written social interaction, a unique and constrained form of talk. Even screen interaction through video is, at best, a two-dimensional form of communication, which deprives children of experience in reading others' faces, voices and bodies directly, as occurs in three-

dimensional face-to-face interaction. Written talk is even more constrained than video, as the analyst does not have access to non-verbal dimensions of the grooming interactions. When this data consists only of written conversation, without the highly informative non-verbal components, such as voice, tone, and gaze, the analyst relies on text, including emoticons. The data at the team's disposal also included a timestamp for each post, which allowed conversation analysts to consider pauses between posts to assist them in understanding the interactional trajectories of rapport building and grooming. Hence where chat transcripts are discussed in this report, they are presented verbatim, with all original errors and timestamps.

Next turn proof procedure

The project focused on how the participants co-organised themselves in the interaction to establish rapport through various types of 'getting to know you' behaviours, before grooming intentions were revealed through the transition sexual post. The use of CA highlights how these behaviours are "socially constructed phenomena" (Peräkylä, 2012, p. 288), which are jointly constructed by participants. The interactional unfolding of becoming acquainted and developing trust can be seen as "expressions that are responsive to the expressions of cointeractants and designed for these cointeractants to perceive and to respond to" (Ibid.). Hence interactants' responses are a crucial element of CA research investigations, which allow the analyst to apply next turn proof procedure. 'Getting to know you' sequences were seen as part of the organised co-constructed sequentiality of the unfolding events. We therefore paid attention not only to the initiator's role, but also to the actions of the recipient in their response. In keeping with principles of CA methodology, "proof-procedure" was applied in the analysis, whereby recipients' responses assist in interpreting how a prior turn was understood (Reeves et al., 2017; Sacks et al., 1974). As noted by Sacks et al. (1974):

...while understandings of other turns' talk are displayed to co-participants they are available as well to professional analysts, who are thereby afforded a proof criterion (and a search procedure) for the analysis of what a turn's talk is occupied with. Since it is the parties' understandings of prior turns' talk that is relevant for their construction of next turns, it is their understandings that are wanted for analysis. The display of those understandings in the talk of subsequent turns affords both a resource for the analysis of prior turns and a proof procedure for professional analyses of prior turns—resources intrinsic to the data themselves (p. 729)

Given that a priori interpretations of data are inappropriate in CA investigations, the analyst relies on responses to prior turns to ensure that interpretations are correct, based on available data. Recipients engage in a similar process, though often 'on the fly', in spoken conversation, or during 'conversation in slow motion' (Beauvois, 1992), which denotes text chat's slower pace due to the need to *write* and *post* rather than *speak* a turn. This methodological practice thus entails the analyst focusing on how the next speaker, or in this case, next 'poster', shows understanding of the prior post. This assists in establishing interpretations which are relevant to the participants, as required in CA methodology. Next turns are therefore essential objects of analysis and sources of evidence for CA researchers. At the same time, they are essential resources for conversationalists to understand and provide evidence of how their turns are understood by recipients.

Data Collection

Obtaining data

The initial aim of this project was to source data which would include transcripts of interactions between online groomers and police decoys acting as children/young people under 18 years of age. Researchers made contact and entered into negotiations with South Australia Police (SAPOL), Courts SA, Victoria Police, Queensland Police and the Australian Federal Police. However, this contact with multiple law enforcement agencies at both the state and federal levels yielded no return, for various reasons. This left the only publicly available data as a source for the application of CA to grooming interactions. Considerable research has previously relied on the Perverted Justice website where transcripts containing interactions between online grooming perpetrators and volunteer child decoys were uploaded during the organisation's period of operation. This organisation has since ceased operations as of the beginning of 2019 and retired their website, though archived data can still be obtained for research and education purposes.

While it is acknowledged that there are differences in interactions involving adult decoys rather than genuine children, the focus of this research is on the language and behaviour of predators. Thus, while some children would have ceased the online interactions much sooner than the adult decoy, the continued conversations provided data on perpetrators. Schneevogt et al. (2018) acknowledge that, despite the differences between genuine children versus decoy responses, the usefulness of the Perverted Justice data may be dependent on the research focus, and it may still be of value in addressing certain questions. Given that differences in behaviour between participants tend to occur later in the interactions, for the purpose of this research (where the focus was on the early, non-sexual stages of interaction), Perverted Justice transcripts can still be of value in applying a new analysis technique such as CA. This data retains the capacity to demonstrate the viability for CA to uncover new information about language and interaction patterns in online grooming contexts.

Data selection


Using archival data from the Perverted Justice website (Perverted Justice, 2019), the most recent capture of the website was used to source the most recent transcripts (n=100) from the list of transcripts associated with convictions. Data recency was prioritised to better reflect the most current language and interaction practices possible within the data set.

The transcripts drawn from the Perverted Justice archive were reviewed and listed in a table to record relevant content including perpetrator and decoy screen names (manually coded by researchers), transcript title, inclusion/exclusion status and reasoning, perpetrator age, decoy presented age, decoy gender, dates of communication (where available), communication platforms, notes, number of total posts, and the post at which the interaction transitioned to sexual. All transcripts were first scanned by one of the researchers based on initial exclusion criteria and reviewed by two other researchers.

From the original selection of 100, six transcripts were found where the perpetrator engaged in two separate conversations with different decoys. These conversations were analysed separately, resulting in 106 transcripts. Ten transcripts were excluded because they did not fit the criteria, leaving 96 transcripts for the first stage of analysis. In this round, given that the focus of the research was on non-sexual language, transcripts were excluded if users

had an overtly sexual screen name, e.g., 'guy_has_hard_cock' or 'hungdude07', or if there was sexual language used within the first three posts. Five transcripts were initially excluded on the basis of sexually explicit or questionable screen names, and a further four were excluded based on questionable posts, e.g. opening posts like 'HIII sexy' or 'hello, do you or would you ever date a married man?'. One further transcript was excluded when it was determined that the interaction recorded was a follow on from an earlier conversation in which the perpetrator did have an overtly sexual screen name. Figure 1 below presents the data selection process.

This exclusion process of team review prompted rigorous discussion about what constitutes sexual language as one of the screen names, initially included, was highlighted for exclusion by a second researcher. Discussion identified that it had been retained during the first round as it could viably have been a surname. Similarly, some of the opening greetings straddled the line of sexuality, which necessitated discussion among researchers to determine what would be classified as sexual. The research team discussed strategies to determine which words were sexual and which were not and agreed that the intended meaning and the context in which particular words were used would determine whether the words would be interpreted as sexual. Applying the next turn proof procedure, researchers reviewed the posts and agreed that if the terms or phrases could be used with any friend or colleague, or as terms that children may

use with their peers as terms of endearment, they could be classified as non-sexual. This resulted in the exclusion of transcripts which opened with 'hi sexy' but the inclusion of those where the decoy was told they were beautiful, as this can be an acceptable compliment.

There were some questionable posts which included statements by the perpetrator such as [I'm] 'too old for you' or [do] 'u like older guys?' Such posts appeared multiple times in the first few exchanges in the transcripts. The researchers agreed to include them as these questions could be interpreted as inquiring for the purpose of gauging the chat participant's sexual interest or just asking if they like older guys to talk to online. Discovering the final intention of the perpetrators allowed researchers to easily identify the intention in these early statements, however, for the purposes of applying the exclusion criteria, these phrases were not considered overtly sexual unless the decoy's interpretation confirms this.

Stage One - Identifying and Analysing the Transition Sexual Post

Identifying the Transition Sexual Post

Once the included transcripts had been selected, the post numbers were counted and reviewed to identify the transition sexual post. The transition sexual post was the post at which point the nature of the conversation became sexually oriented, and the language could no longer be analysed as non-sexual grooming. Initial identification focused heavily on contextbased considerations in play when looking for a single post to mark the move to sexual language. This process required review and discussion between the researchers to identify what would be considered sexual. A sample of transcripts were reviewed by one researcher who highlighted questionable posts before the research team met to review the process and determine the best approach to identify transition sexual posts. Each transcript was then reviewed until an indisputable transition sexual post was identified and questionable posts were highlighted. Posts were highlighted into different colours to signify that they were questionable for different reasons. Some were highlighted for implying rather than declaring interest and having the potential to be interpreted as friendly or technically non-sexual. Other posts were considered borderline but potentially lacking sufficient context within the conversation to be considered the transition sexual post. And finally, while some posts were inappropriate, they contained no clear sexual intent or expression of non-platonic interest in the target. A transition sexual post was indisputable when language was overtly sexual with no scope for misunderstanding, e.g., 'have you ever had sex?' or 'ever seen a cock?'.

The complexity of identifying transition sexual posts arose in the spaces where language was suggestive or inappropriate within an interaction between an adult male and an assumed teen. For example, the posts presented below exemplify the content that was flagged for the listed reasons (numbering recommences at the start of each section to distinguish the different categories).

Implying interest but could be interpreted as friendly, or technically non-sexual:

Example 1

RP0309: if you like could drive to you and we could go to the movies or dinner. How long you been single? and what are your hobbies?

The offender shows clear interest in the target but, despite offering activities that could be considered a romantic date, shows no explicit romantic or sexual intent.

Example 2

RP0000: I hate games, and I don't cheat, lie, or hit.

This is said in response to the decoy saying that so many guys are jerks and they play games. The offender is demonstrating interest by spruiking themselves to the target, declaring that they don't engage in stated behaviours related to intimate relationships, i.e., games and cheating. This could be just about demonstrating positive qualities but appears as an indication of presenting as a good romantic partner.

RP0011: OK babygirl well have a great nite and sweet dreams of US!

The perpetrator's wish for the target to dream of them implies romantic interest, but there is no clear indication of sexual intent.

This nature of questionable posts was also frequently exemplified by perpetrators' persistent interest in obtaining more photographs of decoys, as in Example 3:

Example 3

RP1010: lets see more

Decoy: ok

Decoy: this is my best one
Decoy: do u have a pic?
RP1010: do u have more yet?
Decoy: i have one playing tennis
Decoy: ohhh u look serious

RP1010: lol

RP1010: lets see all your pics

In this example, the perpetrator makes multiple requests for more photos from the decoy. Being heavily interested in their physical appearance implies physical interest in the decoy, but no sexual intent is explicitly demonstrated.

Borderline transition sexual post; includes elements that could represent transition, but contextually are not clear enough to mark the transition sexual post:

Example 1

RP0309: how was your day? and see picture of you standing that could see your whole body. When are you usually home? so we could chat again, good night.

In this case, the request for photos allows the perpetrator to be able to see the target's body. Though there is no explicit evidence of sexual intent, the interest in full body visual implies a sexual interest in viewing the decoy.

Example 2

RP0123: same here trying to fif [fuck I'm funny] if i should get dressed or not

This post could imply that the perpetrator was naked, as they were, but could similarly refer to changing into clothes from pyjamas. The acronym 'fif' has multiple meanings though one option which is relevant to the context was selected. There is no indication by the decoy that it was taken as offensive.

Example 3

RP0011: so would u date me if we got the chance

This post expresses clear interest in the target and aims to assess the target's interest in them but is framed as a hypothetical and as an action at an unknown time in the future. While it indicates romantic interest, it does not indicate clear sexual intent, nor imminent intent to date.

Inappropriate posts that contain no clear sexual intent or expression of non-platonic interest in the target:

Example 1

RP0319-1: oh you aren't? i'll treat you like a woman?

This utterance is posted in response to the decoy saying they're not some bratty kid. Treating the target as a woman carries impropriety as they are known to the offender as a minor. However, treating the target like a woman does not clearly imply sexual actions or intent.

Example 2

RP0712: Lol. Dont do it then princess

This utterance is posted in response to the decoy saying that her mother would take her phone away if she knew that she (the decoy) was communicating with a 23-year-old. This utterance encourages the decoy to conceal their contact from parents which is inappropriate advice for a minor.

Example 3

RP1021: bored chatting love females:)

Knowing that the decoy is assumed to be a 13-year-old female, raising the topic of their attraction to females is inappropriate when simply asked what they were up to as it draws unprompted attention to their romantic interest.

In each case, the posts discussed in the above examples use language which is inappropriate in the context of a conversation occurring between an adult male and an assumed teen, but when drawing a distinct line in the interaction to indicate when it turned sexual, these posts are not sufficient.

Once the process of identification of transition sexual posts was completed for all included transcripts based on the review of classification, a random sample of ten transcripts was shared with three researchers, including one external to the project, to assess the transition sexual post for interrater reliability. A 90% agreement was achieved in this process. Once the transition sexual posts for included transcripts were identified, extracts for analysis were revised for the next round of inclusion criteria. This required the extract to contain a sufficient number of posts to include:

- Initial relationship forming chat
- Small talk/'getting to know you' conversation comprising:
 - Greetings, 'how are you' sequences and personal discussion
 - Age, sex, location questions (ASL) typical of chat
 - Social conversation/chit chat
- Compliments (excluding sexual physical appearance compliments)

- Questions by perpetrator
- Personal self-disclosures by perpetrator
- Requests by perpetrator, e.g., for the target to reveal aspects of their personalities/personal lives (Tudini, 2025).

Explicit and Non-Explicit transition sexual post

Not all transition sexual posts were exemplified by overtly sexual language. While some posts were indisputable in transitioning to sexual language, others were more subtle. What was required to classify a post as a transition sexual post was a clear indication of the perpetrator's intent to engage in sexual activity with the decoy, an interest in their sexual history, or the discussion of sexual topics. Examples of explicit transition sexual posts in Examples 1-7 include:

Example 1

RP2122: are you a virgin?

Example 2

RP0016: I strip in front of you?;)

Example 3

RP0013: hrny?

Example 4

RP3121: sex?

Example 5

RP2804: i could be your secret boyfriend

Example 6

RP3014: sexy pic

Example 7

RP2314: have u ever had sex before?

In more subtle cases, the perpetrator used non-explicit language to guide the decoy into a sexual conversation. This took many different paths including attempts to get the decoy to share or elaborate on previous intimate or sexual experiences with partners, raising nudity as a topic in relation to themselves or the decoy, hinting at inappropriate feelings towards the decoy, or using suggestive language about sexual behaviours. Examples of non-explicit transition sexual posts in Examples 1-6 include:

Example 1

RP1021: so like guys? kissing? more?

In this case, the perpetrator ignored the decoy's question about what they do for fun, instead seeking information about the target's sexual preferences and experiences.

Example 2

RP0123: like i told you i was naked n then i thought daddy not happy to hear that lol

This post followed an earlier post where the perpetrator mentioned getting dressed without explicitly stating they were naked. In this case, they have stated this explicitly to introduce imagery of themselves naked.

Example 3

RP0011: r u one of those that slepp naked??

In this case, the perpetrator is asking about the decoy being naked, showing they were thinking of an assumed teenager without clothes on. This is despite the previous posts stating that the decoy was wearing pyjamas, indicating that the perpetrator was creating a situation to introduce the topic of nudity with the decoy.

Example 4

RP2702: Cool just shorts no shirt lol

In this case, the perpetrator has raised the notion of the decoy having no shirt on despite this not being stated, making this description an example of suggestive language which alludes to partial nudity.

Example 5

RP2008: yes princess...Now im feeling like a perv...lol...OMG!..lol:\">

The perpetrator's post follows their request to keep photos of the decoy. Sharing that this gives them feelings of being a pervert indicates their inappropriate sexual interest in the decoy.

Example 6

RP1920: and if your being bad id just send you to my room!

Here the decoy implies that they want the decoy in their room to be 'bad', with 'bad' having sexual connotations. Additionally, he reframes a usually punitive threat (go to your room) to inappropriately suggest that the decoy should be in his room.

While in most cases the transition sexual post was a single post, there were times when **posts that appeared together** were considered the transition sexual post sequence as the meaning was clearer when spread across multiple posts, as in the examples below.

Example 1

RP0306: what u use to do with him RP0306: i wanna c how mature are u

The question was asked after the perpetrator had asked the decoy if they had had a boyfriend previously and had asked two more times prior what they used to do together. This is where the sexual intent becomes clearer in the questioning about what the target used to do with their boyfriend. The clarification that her response could demonstrate maturity shows the aim is to ascertain sexual experience.

Example 2

RP0519 (08/05/09 11:09:44 PM): or r u a badgirl

Decoy (08/05/09 11:09:46 PM): i like doing random things idk.

Decoy (08/05/09 11:09:54 PM): ya.. i drink sometimes lol RP0519 (08/05/09 11:10:09 PM): i was talkin sexual sorry

In this example, the perpetrator used language which he assumed would be recognised as sexual, but provided clarification, repair, in CA terms, when the decoy did not pick up on this to ensure that they understood that he was seeking sexual information.

The transition sexual post may not have contained any sexual language or overtly direct questions but, in some cases, was represented by the push for more information from the decoy, as in Example 3 below.

Example 3

RP3031 (03/30/07 9:39:05 PM): u do anything

Decoy (03/30/07 9:39:28 PM): yah we went to games and movies and lots of stuff

RP3031 (03/30/07 9:39:38 PM): anything personal Decoy (03/30/07 9:39:56 PM): we kissed and stuff

RP3031 (03/30/07 9:40:03 PM): what stuff

In this case, the perpetrator has not used sexual language or asked the decoy directly about their sexual experience, but they have guided them to the topic and then asked for more information about what the 'stuff' was that they did beyond kissing. This represents interest in the decoy's sexual activity.

Identifying the transition sexual post demonstrated the various ways in which perpetrators shifted conversation towards sexual goals but also highlighted the many questionable posts that appeared before a clear transition could be marked, providing a series of extracts for deeper analysis (see Appendix).

Analysing the Transition Sexual Post

To identify the transcripts' frequently occurring behaviours that unfold in online grooming, the researchers were required to write definitions for the terminology used, from a CA perspective. As terms used in research can mean various things by different researchers, the section entitled 'Linguistic/Interactional definitions of grooming behaviours' in this study seeks to explain their meaning as used herein. Given that research in children's online grooming using a conversation analytic perspective is limited, the process of writing relevant definitions to address the study's objectives required wide reading of the literature, followed by discussion and consultation with the project's team members.

Transition sexual post transcripts from longest to shortest timing

The posts in the perpetrator-decoy collection examined in this research project denote transition sexual posts deployed by the perpetrators in 94 exchanges. Linguistic analysis, combined with application of CA techniques, assisted the project team in the categorisation of the transition sexual posts. Categorisation was based on context, namely, through preceding conversation prior to the transition sexual post. Inclusion of decoy responses up to 10 posts after transition sexual post permitted next turn proof procedure to ensure correct interpretation.

Analysis of the 94 transcripts derived from interactions between 88 perpetrators and decoys reveals that rapport building is a recurrent feature of online grooming interactions using chat. In these transcripts, there were 13,239 posts (see Table 2) up to the transition sexual post. The next ten posts per transcript were included to facilitate the application of next turn proof procedure. This means an additional 940 posts were included. In total, 14,179 posts (see Table 2) were analysed to identify the transition sexual post and descriptor in the first stage. The transition sexual posts analysed and presented in Table 2 indicate that regardless of whether the transition to sexual talk occurs earlier or later in the conversation, the posts are very similar in terms of language and level of sexual explicitness.

Table 1 provides a frequency count and examples for the descriptors in transition sexual posts. This table shows the range of tactics that were employed by perpetrators in their transition of the conversation to a sexual nature, but what is most relevant is the repeated appearance of sexualised language, questions, sexualised compliments, and suggestive language. It is unsurprising that sexualised language would be present in a shift towards a sexual conversation, but it rarely appeared alone (n=3). All instances of questions were either sexual (n=26) or suggestive (n=10). This demonstrates that when questions and compliments become suggestive or sexual, the nature of the conversation is about to turn, making the appearance of such conversational actions concerning for young people interacting with older conversational partners. Table 2 provides the full list of descriptors for each transition sexual post and a full list of the excerpts where the transition sexual post is located in each of the 94 transcripts can be found in the Appendix.

Stage Two – Analysis of rapport building behaviours between perpetrators and decoys

To enable ease of understanding of linguistic terminology and classifications relative to online interactions, the following descriptions and examples informed the analysis.

Linguistic/Interactional Analysis of Grooming Behaviours

Transition Sexual Post

A transition sexual post is a post where conversation changes orientation from small talk (see definition below) and general 'getting to know you' conversation, to sexual, as indicated by reference to sex through request for more information, testing sexual boundaries or inappropriate compliments. In the example below, post number 3665 is the transition sexual post, as indicated by the focal arrow, as the perpetrator reveals his deviant sexual orientation. Pseudonyms assigned to the participants are 'Decoy' (the child decoy) and, in this example, 'RP1107' (the perpetrator).

Rapport building

Rapport building is the process of establishing and developing relationships (Chiang, 2018), also referred to as 'emotional connection' (Aitken et al., 2018), or when rapport building is for the purpose of ill intention, it can be recognised as 'deceptive trust development' (Lorenzo-Dus et al., 2016). Fogarty et al. (2013, p. 398) propose that progressivity (a CA concept) in interaction is an element of rapport. Progressivity is "the smooth, collaborative completion of actions within a given sequence of interaction" (Fogarty et al., 2013, p. 414). Progressivity means progressing a particular activity or social action through a sequence of turns, and how speakers collaborate in order to achieve this concept in a relatively smooth and unproblematic manner (Fogarty et al., 2013, p. 398). The social actions in the data of the current study include gaining the victim's trust and grooming, that lead to sexual/romantic conversation. Rapport building is a process that is achieved by utilising a number of behaviours defined below, including phatic communication (small talk), which serves to maintain conversation (Chiang, 2018; Chiang & Grant, 2017; Gauz, 2014; Kloess et al., 2019; Lorenzo-Dus et al., 2016).

Small talk

Hudak and Maynard (2011, p. 635) state that "small talk is a category for varieties of conversational interaction occurring in many settings", noting that research has relied heavily on commonsense notions of small talk as social conversation or chitchat. Participants use small talk to find ways in which they are alike (Hudak & Maynard, 2011, p. 651), also known as 'seeking commonality' (Tudini & Strambi, 2017). For the purpose of this project, small talk can be defined as sharing information that is not of a personal or private nature. Examples may include the sharing of information about entertainment, hobbies, school, work, daily activities and technical matters.

In conversation analytic terms, small talk can be divided into various sub-categories as follows: openings, closings, 'getting to know you' behaviours, chat openings, such as ASL, affiliative behaviours, and self-disclosures.

- Openings

In CA, the 'opening' of a conversation constitutes a greeting sequence and is commonly followed by a 'how are you?' sequence. Openings typically consist of contact initiation, greetings, and topic initiation. The following is an example of a prototypical polite opening sequence as shown in turns 1254,1255 and 1257, where the participants greet each other and then ask one another how they are. In the following excerpt, the greeting (post 1254) also establishes the recipient's identity, exchanges are made regarding how they are (posts 1255 and 1257), and topic initiation (about their day) is seen in post 1260. For the purpose of this study, 'how are yous' are not considered a prompted self-disclosure because they form part of the opening sequence.

Age, sex, and location (ASL)

Openings in text chat which feature solicitations of age, sex, and location are known as 'ASL' (Chiang & Grant, 2017; Gauz, 2014; Lorenzo-Dus et al., 2016; Powell et al., 2021). In CA terms, this ASL acronym is a type of 'getting to know you' behaviour which aims to gain key information about the interlocutor quickly and normally occurs at the start of chat interaction. In the example below, the acronym is used by the perpetrator in post 7.

- Closings

'Closings' in CA terminology are the words used to end or sign off a conversation. Leave-taking behaviours usually occur before separation from social interaction, as seen in the following example. Closings consist of topic termination (seen in post 2614), leave-taking, and contact termination (post 2026) (Schegloff & Sacks, 1973).

'Getting to know you' behaviours

Self-disclosure

Self-disclosures are used by perpetrators to promotes responses from the target. There are various types of self-disclosures, as defined below. For the purpose of this study, if a self-disclosure is of a non-personal or non-private nature, then they are termed non-personal self-disclosures and are categorised under 'getting-to-know-you' behaviours because they do not seem to be inappropriate for the context. Examples of non-personal self-disclosures may include the sharing of information about entertainment, hobbies, school, work, daily activities and technical matters. These non-personal self-disclosures can then be further categorised under the following headings: prompted, unprompted and unprompted sequence-initial self-disclosure (or new topic initiation).

- Prompted self-disclosure

Haugh and Carbaugh (2015) define prompted self-disclosure as any self-descriptive information offered in response to a direct question. For example, in post 297 of the exchange below, the target (Decoy) responds to the perpetrator's direct question about the grade they are in at school.

- Unprompted self-disclosure

Haugh and Carbaugh (2015) defined unprompted self-disclosure as that which is volunteered, although it could be encouraged by a previous partner's disclosure or, more broadly, by topic relevance. Post 438 below is an example of unprompted self-disclosure because the decoy volunteers the given information that was not asked of them.

- Unprompted sequence-initial self-disclosure or new topic initiation

When participants volunteer personal information by initiating a new topic sequence, which can be understood as an unprompted change of topic, their posts can be categorised as unprompted sequence-initial self-disclosure (Strambi & Tudini, 2020). Turn 514 below is an example of unprompted sequence-initial self-disclosure because the volunteered information (about the perpetrator writing poetry) is unrelated to the previous discussion.

Assessing risk/probing vulnerabilities

Perpetrators of child abuse tend to assess children/young people based on vulnerability, access, and control. In online sexual grooming, the language associated with assessing their risk, includes asking questions to assess the targets' environment in terms of being alone, movements, and proximity of parents. These elements of victims' background all inform the perpetrators' understanding of risk for the purposes of in-person child sexual abuse (Aitken et al., 2018; Chiang, 2018; Gauz, 2014; van Gijn-Grosvenor & Lamb, 2016; Williams et al., 2013). In children's online grooming, there is evidence of perpetrators probing the target's vulnerabilities via questions in personal self-disclosures. Unlike non-personal self-disclosures, these seem to be designed to access personal or private information from the target that is inappropriate for a minor to give in an online context to an adult stranger. The nature of the questions may include family movements, problems, living arrangements, dreams, feelings/thoughts, identity, specific location, or probing/inappropriate questions such as "what do u want from me?" As was the case for non-personal self-disclosures, personal self-disclosures can then be categorised as being prompted, unprompted or unprompted sequence-initial self-disclosure (new topic initiation).

An instance of assessing risk in the data via a personal prompted self-disclosure is where the perpetrator assesses the risk by investigating the decoy's family living arrangements and personal feelings to identify the chat participant's vulnerabilities, by using questions to seek information, as seen in posts 742 and 744.

Assessing risk/probing vulnerabilities can also be seen in the action of testing sexual boundaries. Questions between the perpetrator and the decoy regarding age difference, previous romantic or sexual experiences, current relationship status, as well as bed-related talk

such as, "What pyjamas are you wearing?" In posts 818, 821, 832, 834 and 837, the perpetrator asks personal questions to prompt the decoy to self-disclose about whether the decoy has a boyfriend, the boyfriend's age, and what happened in the former relationship. Dotted lines (--) in this and other examples of this study, indicate that text was removed because it was irrelevant to the discussion.

Affiliative behaviours

This section considers affiliative behaviours, which consist of positive assessments (compliments), advice-giving, apologies, and negative assessments (criticising others and self-deprecation).

Positive assessments

In conversation analytic terminology, "assessments are turns which provide an evaluation" (Liddicoat, 2021, p. 149) and may be either positive or negative (Heritage, 1985). Positive assessments are a component of online grooming in this study. In the data, they are evident mainly as compliments that the participants (especially the perpetrator) pay one another during their chats.

- Compliments

Compliments are used by the perpetrator to create a positive environment for interaction to make the target feel special, promoting continued interaction to facilitate later abuse (Williams et al., 2013). Keisanen and Kärkkäinen (2014, p. 650) define compliments as "actions that positively evaluate the appearance, personal qualities, or actions of a co-present participant. As such, compliments can be thought of as a particular type of assessment." In previous CA research, assessments have been defined as actions used for the evaluation of persons, objects and events that have been described in conversation (Goodwin & Goodwin, 1987, 1992; Pomerantz, 1984). According to Keisanen and Kärkkäinen (2014), a working definition of compliments is lacking in CA literature. Shaw and Kitzinger (2012, p. 241) limit their definition of complimenting as, "an action carried out largely or solely through positive

assessments". The findings of the CA study by Keisanen and Kärkkäinen (2014) indicate that a frequently used linguistic format when complimenting included, "the second-person pronoun *you*, while copula *be* is the most common verb and most frequently appears in the present tense. The evaluative item is in almost all cases either an adjective in its base form or a noun phrase. Compliments: **[you] + [are] + [(highly) positive ADJ/NP**]" (Keisanen & Kärkkäinen, 2014, p. 653). For example, turn 2456 below follows the above-mentioned linguistic format.

The example above is a form of positive assessment of others. In the online grooming context, there is also positive assessment of self.

- Advice-giving to promote protective stance

Another component of positive assessments in the grooming behaviours encountered in the data, initiated solely by the perpetrator in this study, is advice-giving to promote a protective stance. In previous research regarding online sexual grooming, although not specifically CA-based, 'positivity' refers to the perpetrators' aim of presenting themselves in a positive light, or as a friend (Albert, 2014; Williams et al., 2013). This definition is relevant to the notion of positive self-assessment in CA.

In the following example, the perpetrator provides advice or warning to the victim in post 12, about perverts, which put him in a positive light. The decoy positively assesses people in chat in turn 13, when she says, "na some nice ppl."

- Apologies

Another component of the grooming behaviours encountered in the data is apologies. An apology is a form of politeness marker (Terkourafi, 2011), which is a linguistic expression employed to show politeness (Watts, 2003, p. 2). In the excerpt below, the perpetrator gave numerous pieces of advice to the target to promote a protective stance. Arrowed posts 3025 and 3030 display apologies by the perpetrator, as he said sorry for talking too much and for providing advice.

Negative assessments

The CA notion of negative assessments may be applied to the linguistic behaviour of perpetrators when they attempt to criticise or defame the target's loved ones, or criticise the decoy. In post 2226 below, the perpetrator uses coarse language to criticise the decoy's father.

Perpetrators may also negatively self-assess themselves online, known as self-deprecation.

Self-deprecation

Self-deprecation is a behaviour evident in social interaction. It is seen when a participant tries to make themselves, their abilities, or their achievements seem less important, or is enacted in self-criticism (e.g., when a perpetrator says, "I am not nice"). It may be initiated by the speaker in order for the recipient to disagree with them and offer the contrary opinion, such as when the target responds in their second pair part with, "Oh, yes you are!" This may be intentionally designed by the perpetrator to obtain a compliment from the target.

In the example below, prior to post 1854 (not reproduced), the perpetrator recited a poem that he had written. In this excerpt, the perpetrator self-deprecates three times at arrowed posts 1856, 1857 and 1859. The decoy negates the put-downs in posts 1858 and 1860, which is possibly what the perpetrator desired in linguistically designing his texts to achieve praise from the target.

Announcements acting as emotional blackmail or threats

Emotional blackmail can be defined as a psychological strategy of coercion. It can be used for the control of others by means of threats likely to lead to fear (e.g., "if you don't do this, something bad will happen"), obligation by means of requests ("you owe me this because...") also designed to promote guilt ("I would be so hurt if you didn't do this"). Emotional blackmail often occurs in various life domains and negatively impacts the victim's well-being and relationships (Kao, 2024; Najem & Abbas, 2024). From a CA perspective, emotional blackmail is often designed interactionally as a threatening action. Hepburn and Potter (2011), state that threats are formed from a conditional logic: if the recipient continues the problem action, or does not initiate the required action, then negative consequences will be produced by the speaker.

In the context of online grooming, emotional blackmail may be designed interactionally through deployment of announcements, threatening behaviours, and requests. These may include the perpetrator announcing the following: their withdrawal from the chat, the discussion of their own or another's death, or repeated requests that the decoy reveals personal information. Emotional blackmail may also be evident in online grooming when the perpetrator offers a bribe/enticement or advises that the target should keep something a secret. These emotional appeals are framed within conversations, including the language used, the social context, and the power dynamics between speakers. The perpetrator's announcements threatening withdrawal from chat and his possible death in posts 2355, 2357 and 2370 are responded to by the decoy with an emoticon expressing sadness in 2358 and an invitation to return to the chat in 2375.

Micro-analysis

For the purposes of this research, 10% of the 94 transcripts were selected for microanalysis. The 10 transcripts chosen had the highest number of rapport-building posts before the transition sexual post.

Table 3 provides data on the ten longest transcripts in this study, in terms of the post numbers at which the transition sexual post was reached. Transcripts are placed in descending order of transition sexual post numbers, from the highest number of posts it took for the perpetrator to transition to a sexual orientation, to the lowest. The figures indicate that in all transcripts listed (except for Transcript 6), the perpetrators had more posts and therefore more control over the texted conversation than the decoys.

Micro-analysis of the 6,832 posts analysed in these 10 transcripts showed that, overall, the perpetrators' posts amounted to 57.2% of the posts in their text chats with the decoys. On average, the transition sexual post was reached at 19.3% of the text chat conversation.

Procedure

The transcripts were initially analysed to identify features of interaction between the perpetrator and the decoy, notably: rapport building via small talk (including openings, closings, 'getting to know you' behaviours through non-personal self-disclosures); assessing risk/probing vulnerabilities via personal self-disclosures; testing sexual boundaries; affiliative behaviours (positive assessments, and self-deprecation); and announcements to enact threats and promote emotional blackmail, for example, threatening to withdraw from the chat. This process enabled a quantitative overview of key features. The process involved a meticulous search for examples of interactional practices highlighted by previous research on children's online grooming and relevant studies that used CA as their methodology. Once the search was complete, the researchers created several tables based on key features and frequently occurring interactional behaviours identified in the data.

Based on the 10 transcripts where there was the most rapport building, Table 4 summarises the frequency of initiated rapport building behaviours. The self-disclosures in this table are labelled 'non-personal' and form part of the 'getting to know you' interaction in small talk. The figures indicate that the perpetrators had a greater proportion of posts initiating small talk; specifically, openings, closings, non-personal prompted self-disclosures and new topic.

Of the 271 instances of non-personal prompted self-disclosure, just over two thirds (68.6%) of these posts were initiated by the perpetrator. The main topics of focus were entertainment/hobbies (34%) and enquiring about what activities the decoy was engaging in (31%). Each of these topics occurred more than twice as frequently as any other non-personal prompted self-disclosure. Of interest is that 77.4% of initiated topic change (non-personal unprompted sequence-initial self-disclosure) was initiated by the perpetrator (see Table 4).

Table 5 summarises the data regarding the initiation of behaviours that assess risk and probe the vulnerabilities of the decoys through personal self-disclosures. More than three quarters (78.1%) of the prompted self-disclosure chats were initiated by perpetrators, which largely involved inquiring about and monitoring the decoys' feelings/thoughts (20.1%) and inquiring about family and family movements (9.5%). Again, perpetrators initiated new topics (personal unprompted sequence-initial self-disclosure) much more (87.9%) than the decoys.

Table 6 provides a summary of initiated affiliative behaviours. The figures indicate that in all cases of advice giving relative to promoting a protective stance, posts were made by the perpetrator. The perpetrators had slightly more posts with initiated instances of compliments (positive assessments) (54.8%) and apologies (66.6%). It should be noted that there were no criticisms of the other chat participant regarding appearance, intelligence or achievement.

This initial analysis laid the basis for identifying sequence organisation and patterns of behaviour occurring across the transcripts. Informed by the work of Stivers (2015), the following tables (Tables 4-7) present a basic quantitative perspective on the data, informed by CA principles. This perspective provides a summary of the data collected and represents the initial step taken in the CA analysis, which then led to qualitative micro-analysis of patterns of behaviour that are presented in this project and help to respond to its aims. Some of this micro-analysis is presented in this report.

Table 7 summarises the frequency of announcements acting as emotional blackmail or threats. Almost all (97.4%) blackmail/threat posts were posted by the perpetrator. Controlling behaviour through persistent questions was most evident in 62.1% of instances.

Limitations

A recent systematic review by members of this research team (Tudini et al., under review) revealed there had been minimal research: a) on non-sexual online interactions; b) examining micro-level discourse features, as is done using CA or discourse analysis approaches, and c) involving genuine children, with most studies based on police and vigilantes acting as child decoys. Online interactions with adult decoys are unlikely to entail the use of the same language and interactional resources as those with genuine children in the same contexts. This is because while perpetrators' language and interactional behaviour is the same across contexts involving children or adult decoys, responses are likely to vary. Additional variation is likely according to the age of children, where younger children under 12 are likely to respond and behave differently from older children. Other linguistic studies in this area confirm the importance of analysing conversations between online predators and genuine children rather than police decoys (Chiang & Grant, 2019).

While research using authentic datasets involving perpetrators chatting with genuine children would provide important insights on grooming trajectories in online conversation, the cooperation of law enforcement is required. Law enforcement cooperation is, however, reliant on police resources to obtain and de-identify perpetrator and genuine child transcripts. While valuable data has been identified through the Perverted Justice archives and used fruitfully in the current research, the original project was intended to include participants consisting of perpetrators and police decoys rather than vigilante child decoys. However, despite our efforts, the research team was unable to obtain approval to access data from four police jurisdictions (SA, QLD, VIC, AFP) and the SA courts. For this reason, the team relied on the Perverted Justice archives for its investigation as the data involved perpetrators and decoys pretending to be children, as intended in the original project. While perpetrator language and interactional features are authentic, decoys' responses are less so, because genuine children are likely to respond differently in accordance with their age. For example, the aggression by perpetrators toward children rather than decoys may be explained by decoys offering less resistance than a genuine child who may feel unsure or unsafe in the reviewed interactions. Further research using perpetrator-genuine child transcriptions can provide greater insights into manipulation tactics.

Nonetheless perpetrator-decoy interactions are a valid object of study for the purpose of identifying the conversational behaviours of perpetrators to enact rapport-building in non-sexual online grooming. The transition sexual posts were initiated by perpetrators rather than decoys; hence, findings related to this interactional and linguistic turning point in the interaction are valuable for the prevention of child sexual exploitation.

Concluding Summary and Comments

Summary of findings

Analysis has indicated that various types of rapport building behaviours are present in online grooming interactions. There is a point where rapport-building transitions from non-sexual to sexually oriented interaction, namely, the transition sexual post. It was necessary to identify this point first, taking context and decoy responses into account before analysing rapport building. Analysis of the 94 transition sexual posts found that perpetrators were the only initiators of such posts. The transition sexual posts were expressed in a variety of linguistic ways, from sexually explicit to more indirect but sexually suggestive ways. 36 of the 94 transition

sexual posts (38%) were predominantly in the form of questions. Over half of the transition sexual posts included questions, requests, or invitations (53.2% or 50 out of 94). A significant proportion of transition sexual posts were evident as compliments, known as positive assessments in CA terms (22.3% or 21 of 94 transition sexual posts).

The micro-analysis identified that perpetrators were more likely than decoys to initiate non-personal prompted self-disclosure using questions (68.6%), whereas personal unprompted self-disclosure via questions were somewhat balanced between the perpetrator and the decoy. New conversation topics were predominantly initiated by the perpetrator in the non-personal unprompted sequence-initial self-disclosures (77.4%). Conversely, the non-personal unprompted self-disclosure questions were balanced between participants. Personal prompted self-disclosures using questions (78.1%) and personal unprompted sequence initial self-disclosures (new topic initiation) (87.9%) were initiated more often by the perpetrator than the decoy. Initiation of positive assessments (compliments) were balanced between the perpetrator and the decoy. Emotional blackmail and threatening behaviours were predominantly initiated by the perpetrator (97.4%), and advice giving to promote a protective stance was only carried out by the perpetrator (100% of instances). Both openings and closing of conversations were initiated more so by the perpetrator.

Concluding Comments

Rapport building behaviours such as greetings and compliments are affiliative behaviours in both online grooming and other social online contexts. The most salient and risky rapport-building behaviours identified in this study, and which are designed to elicit information from the target for the purpose of child sexual exploitation, include topic change and personal self-disclosures, which are predominantly initiated by the perpetrator. Self-disclosure by the perpetrator has been previously shown to elicit disclosures from the target (Tudini, 2025) so these results confirm the deliberate use of this conversational strategy by offenders.

Prior to the current project, the only CA study identified in our systematic literature review (Tudini, et. al., under review) was research by Pfister (2017) who had clearly identified topic change as a feature of perpetrators' language, through the analysis of five transcripts. Numbers of posts in her analysis were not identified. This tendency by the perpetrator is confirmed in the current project's dataset of the 10 longest non-sexual rapport building exchanges, in which there were 6,832 posts. This has implications for detection of perpetrators because it suggests controlling behaviours in conversation. Alongside self-disclosure and topic change, key linguistic behaviours by perpetrators included asking excessive questions, giving sexualised compliments, asking for multiple pictures, and asking about prior relationships or any romantic or intimate experiences. This is important to inform public education including teachers, children, parents and police decoys. It also reflects how the power differential between participants could be expressed through linguistic and interactional behaviours, though further replication of this study is required in perpetrator-child (rather than decoy) chat.

Given the crisis in child sexual exploitation (Australian Federal Police, 2024), and that online grooming is an action in which intent is often disguised, further CA investigations could further advance our understanding of how grooming trajectories are enacted and what specific language is used in perpetrator-child interactional contexts to identify patterns in linguistic and conversational behaviours. The specific interactional features of rapport-building as grooming, and how grooming is accomplished through language and conversation remain under-explored. A focus on examining micro-level discourse features, as is done using CA, is required to

understand the language and discursive accomplishment of online grooming - see Gauz (2014). Understanding of patterns of non-sexual grooming behaviour requires further development to be able to improve efforts to detect perpetrators as early as possible in their exchanges with children. The information gained from this research can feed directly into educative efforts which can be targeted towards children and protective adults.

Further research using authentic datasets involving genuine children is required, given project findings which suggest that CA can provide useful insights into the enactment of online grooming, including evidence of perpetrator domination of the online conversation. Such datasets can, however, only be accessed through collaboration with law enforcement agencies in or outside Australia. Collaboration with law enforcement is reliant on police resources to obtain and de-identify perpetrator and genuine child transcripts. Therefore, appropriate well-resourced police jurisdictions need to be identified for this research.

Being able to analyse grooming behaviours, particularly as they occur in initial non-sexual stages, and involving genuine children, can offer critical information for the earlier identification of perpetrators and improve our understanding of how genuine children behave linguistically in online grooming interaction. The limited research that involves genuine children, identified in this project, highlights that this a significant gap in current understanding.

While this project has initiated the process, further research is required to distinguish grooming and benign 'getting to know you' behaviours. Identifying similarities and differences between grooming practices and ordinary conversational small talk through CA analysis will provide children and protective adults with the literacy required to identify cumulative risks. Particular statements may not appear problematic, but helping young people to assess the intent of their conversational partners may encourage them to exit unsafe communication sooner.

Future research on genuine children's interaction may also inform undercover police decoy operative training. If such operations are better informed in recurrent initial grooming behaviours and authentic children's responses, they may be better able to re-enact genuine children's responses and target efforts towards likely perpetrators from an earlier stage of interaction.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the following strategies are implemented to prevent online child sexual grooming and online child sexual abuse and exploitation:

- Community campaign to educate parents on the conversational tactics of online sexual perpetrators. For example, children and protective adults need to learn to gauge whether a chat partner is dominating the online interaction by asking excessive questions, frequently changing topic, and disclosing personal information to prompt similar self-disclosures in the child.
- Educational programs, such as protective behaviours programs, child protection programs, media literacy, and cybersafety, need to incorporate patterns of behaviour used by perpetrators to groom children online. For example, as outlined in the first point, as well as moving the conversation from a public forum to a more private forum.

- Software of platforms should detect when language transitions to a sexual nature to then alert the child or young person to immediately cease engagement and report/block the offender. This could be implemented by warning systems facilitated by AI.
- Media providers are made accountable for social media interactions to monitor sexual exploitation of minors
- Training for police decoys includes understanding and recognising transition sexual posts
- Review of funding models to facilitate research collaboration between law enforcement staff involved in the protection of children from online groomers and research teams who are engaged in relevant research.
- A research focus on online interactions between genuine children and perpetrators is required to understand how children of different ages respond to online grooming, and to train police decoys to imitate children's behaviours in this context.
- Further research is required on how to distinguish genuine rapport building behaviour from grooming related behaviours online.
