Sheetmetal Australia (SMA) have hosted several interns across different disciplines since joining the program in early 2020. SMA's Director, Tammie Blackmore, highlights how this has been beneficial to the company and resulted in their newest employee:

"2020 was a challenging year for many. A year we decided to focus to develop some of our ideas that were long overdue. With the assistance of Daryl McMahon and his team, we were able to convert some of our ideas into projects that enabled us to utilise the internship program at UniSA.

Jack Barnes was an intern we engaged with for a 15-day placement, where he was tasked to research our current marketing position and provide a report about how we could improve our presence in the marketplace. We were very impressed with his quality of work and ability to work well within the culture of our business that we decided to provide him with a part time position to implement his plan and provide additional support to our admin team, the program is a great way for us to gain fresh ideas and skills into our team as well as seeing if they would be suitable to fit into our work culture. We are now looking forward to our next lot of interns to complete our new ideas we are now creating!"

UniSA student, Jack Barnes, talks about the impact of the program for him:

"My decision to participate within the marketing practicum program was a simple one, and I regard it as one of the most influential choices of my university journey thus far. Entering the final year of my Marketing and Communications degree, I lacked the necessary relevant industry experience and knowledge required to gain significant employment following my graduation, so an industry placement was the perfect option for me.

Beginning in the second semester of 2020, my 15 days of placement at Sheetmetal Australia (SMA) provided me with the opportunity to broaden my networks and finally put the theory I had learned over the previous two and half years to practical use. Tasked with the job of developing a marketing report for SMA, I wholly threw myself into my role, gathering and analyzing all relevant data and resources I could get my hands on. With assistance from SMA staff, I was able to obtain one of the highest grades of my degree within the marketing practicum class. However, more importantly, I was able to gain experience, relevant industry contacts and a great referee for my resume.

Following the completion of my 15-day placement, I was graciously offered a part time digital marketing assistant position at SMA to implement recommendations stated within my marketing report. My experience has been one of not only learning but enjoyment as well, and I will continue to recommend the marketing practicum class to students alongside SMA as a placement destination."
