#### What is the mix of disciplines so far?

Last month I showed the percentage breakdown of student registrations by discipline, and that largely hasn't changed. So what I have done this month is show the current ratios of students to industry. The overall average is 1.74 students registered per industry attending, down from 1.96 in April, demonstrating the increase in industry participation in the event. Current ratios by discipline are shown here, the highlighted ones are where we would like to see more of you involved:
