What is the mix of disciplines so far?

Student registrations are pushing past 190 so we're expecting close to 250. We average a >60% show rate so current tracking for an industry to student ratio of 1:2. Here's the current breakdown by discipline:

June cohort Project Briefs – when to submit?

As per the <u>Key Dates for the Program</u>, we are aiming to have Project Briefs submitted by at least a day ahead of the networking event. This is due to two reasons:

- 1. Helps ensure you have a plan for the type(s) of opportunities you are seeking to fill.
- 2. We advertise opportunities the following week and some of the June cohort won't be able to attend the networking event so maximises the likelihood of your opportunity being filled.

It's a tight turnaround which unfortunately can't be helped. We schedule these two activities into the 2 week long mid-semester break so as to keep disruption to current courses to a minimum.
