The UniSA Exercise Physiology Clinic offers specialist exercise testing and prescription services to assist with the management and prevention of chronic health conditions, musculoskeletal rehabilitation, medical conditions, disabilities and mental health conditions. We also offer high performance development programs to professional and elite athletes and teams, as well as amateur athletes.

Treatment is provided by final year undergraduate students under the supervision of accredited exercise physiologists, or directly by accredited exercise physiologists.
