Take your first step towards a career as a commercial pilot.

We offer a highly-flexible flying program with four distinct pathway options.

All students apply for and start in the Bachelor of Aviation (Flight).

Within the first semester, you may apply for PATHWAY 1, our flagship program that includes a full suite of licences and ratings to make you entry level airline-ready. Successful students into this pathway will graduate with a **Bachelor of Aviation** (Pilot) and **Graduate Diploma in Aviation**.

Other students may prefer PATHWAYS 2, 3 or 4, which include a taste of flying (15-20 hours) in the bachelor degree, followed by optional CPL or PPL qualifications.

Please note that studying a bachelor and pilot licence at the same time is a challenging workload.
