As you are aware we have been closely monitoring the incidences and rates of COVID-19 infection in the SA community, and are adapting our approach accordingly and as informed by public health advice.

Based on the State's caseload and trajectory of COVID-19 infections since 25<sup>th</sup> July, please note the following adjustments to the university's COVID-19 management measures:

- Mask wearing is no longer a general mandatory requirement, but is **strongly recommended** in all indoor shared spaces on all UniSA campuses. Please note that certain university activities and settings do still *require* mask wearing under ongoing public health mandates.
- As per Academic Board's recent determination, lectures and examinations will remain online.
- Face to face meetings, teaching and research activities can transition as appropriate over the coming days back to being conducted in person.
