You may be aware of the Premier's press conference held earlier this morning relating to the management of COVID19 transmission in South Australia. To summarise, there are no new health directives in place beyond those introduced on Monday of this week.

The University continues to implement strict adherence to all applicable directives, to established social distancing protocols and education remains an essential service.

No 'work from home' directive is in effect at this time, however, should staff from identified high-risk groups wish to discuss amendment of their working arrangements with their line manager, that option remains available.
